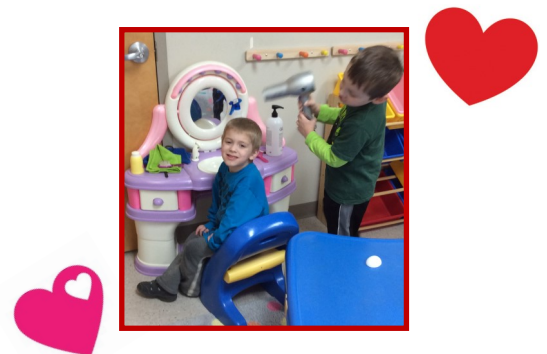


Valentines mail fun is one of the month’s highlights. We will learn to cut hearts and how to write “I love you”. Playing mailman is always a good time.

Family Promise is God’s Work ... Our Hands

As you read this article, some people are preparing to spend nights at church. The next dates where we host families experiencing homelessness are February 3-10. People often ask me, “How is Family Promise going?” The best answer I have for you is to come and join us and find out!



Each time we host, there are 79 volunteer slots to fill, with most volunteers signing up for several slots. Tasks that require no orientation include: Set-up; Donate food; Take-down; and Laundry. The following jobs, where you have contact with our guests, require a short orientation by one of our Family Promise Coordinators: Van driving; Meal preparation and serving; Evening Host; Overnight Host; and Day Center coverage. We can get you oriented at your own convenience.

All communications for the Family Promise volunteers come through emails, and all sign-ups are done using Sign Up Genius which is accessed through faithspicer.org. If you’ve been wondering about jumping into this mission, or even getting your toes wet, please e-mail Lynn Dwyer at dwyerl@charter.net. We can get you a description of each volunteer job.

If you belong to a group that would like to raise funds for Family Promise of Kandiyohi County, that is FANTASTIC. Without the work of the Director/Case Manager, and the services at the Day Center, this non-profit work would not be possible.

Minnesota Food Share

Did you know that MN FoodShare Month doesn't just happen during the month of March? The Link Food Pantry is able to count pounds of food and monetary funds donated from February 25 - April 7.



2019 March Campaign Hunger Facts:

- Nearly one in ten Minnesotans experience food insecurity.
- 13.8% of children in Minnesota are food insecure.
- 9.5% of Minnesotans live below the poverty level.
- Over 3,000,000 visits were made to Minnesota food shelves each year, 2011-2017, with over 3.4 million visits in 2017.

The number of food insecure seniors and seniors utilizing food shelves continues to increase.

Minnesota's charitable food system (food shelves and food banks, meal programs, etc.) continues to run at capacity. Supporting government programs like SNAP ("food stamps") and creating a more just and equitable food system are integral parts of meeting the needs of food insecure households and working toward ending hunger in our communities.
