The season of Lent traditionally has an emphasis on catechesis, (the learning and reflecting on the chief tenants of our faith in preparation for baptism). It also has had an emphasis on fasting, prayer, and almsgiving individually in preparation for Holy Week. This learning and piety were meant to make us sensitive to God's work in the world – God's love for humanity – and the power of Jesus' death and resurrection for us. It is a compressed time with an incredible outcome of reframing our lives toward God and with hope toward the future.

This year I am inviting you to join us for a Lenten series called: "The Masks of God." The series tests the limits of our knowledge of God and our wanting to "pierce" behind the veil of God's work. This includes where God is in suffering or when we feel abandoned. The key question asked is "Where is God now?" And the key verse is from Isaiah 45:15, "Truly, you are a God who hides himself, O God of Israel, the Savior."

Join me to listen deeply to God's Word and be transformed in our thinking about God!
