#### Christ is risen!!! He is risen indeed!!!

These words which we speak on Easter morning, trigger for me deep-seated memories of groggy Easter Sunday mornings, having prepared breakfast in a church basement, and then heading up to the sanctuary to hear this proclamation, Christ is risen!!! He is risen indeed!!! These words may flood our memories with the sights, sounds, smells, and emotions of Easter.

Sights - The stained glass windows of the sanctuary, with the



light of Easter dawn shining on the altar, as if to say, "See the tomb is empty, he is not here". The bright-colored hats of the women in church, little girls in pastel dresses, and Easter Egg colored clip on ties of the little boys all seemed to serve as a revealing sign that God has done something miraculous and new. The white cloth draped over the cross, reminds us that life has replaced the black shroud of death which was the last image of Good Friday.

Sounds - First there is silence...then hope...then proclamation, "Christ is Risen!!! He is Risen Indeed!!!" ...then trumpets. Then voices singing the promise, "Jesus Christ is Risen Today! Alleluia!" The sounds of Easter are sounds of joy! A sneak peek at the heavenly chorus we will some day join. The sounds of Easter are sounds of victory!!! The devil has lost, Christ has conquered. The sounds Easter continues to resound as each reading, hymn and prayer proclaim the incredible power of God in the resurrection of Jesus.

Smells - Only on Easter Sunday do the sweet aromas of hyacinth and lily mingle so well with the smells of sausage, bacon, scrambled eggs, and coffee from the Easter breakfast. For some the smell of a lily will carry them back to the pew where the whole family, grandparents, aunts, uncles and cousins sang "Thine Is The Glory!"

Emotions - What a joyful, transformation from the gloom and death of Good Friday to the wonder and surprise of the empty tomb of Easter. Angels ask drowsy disciples, "Why do you look for the living among the dead?" Do we not feel the heart rate of Peter rising as he sprints to the tomb. I would even try to imagine that I was Peter and the surprise and amazement I would have experienced at the empty tomb.

The gospel writer Luke tells us, that these experiences were much different on that very first Easter day. Those first disciples, the ones to whom the women reported the news of the empty tomb, they regarded it as an idle tale. To them it was too much, too miraculous, too unbelievable to be true. Even the two disciples on the road to Emmaus had difficulty comprehending this news until Jesus came alongside of them to open their eyes and their hearts to this good news. For us however, this good news of Easter is no idle tale! It is truth!!!




