Friends in Christ,

It has been a long wait, this past year. This waiting began for most of us on March 11, 2020, when the news hit that the Corona Virus had become a global pandemic. In our waiting, we adjusted and adapted. We tried new ways of working and worshipping. We tapped hidden creativity and tucked away talents as we sought to be the church together from a distance. We also experienced grief and disappointment. Major life events were postponed or canceled. Celebrations were scaled back. Plans were put on hold. And we grieved loss. Loss of life, loss of loved ones, loss of health and wellbeing, loss of a way of life. The pandemic that began in the season of Lent 2020 seemed to drag our lenten burdens beyond the forty days of Lent. And so we experienced life quite differently for the past year or so.

Despite the pandemic, we continued to journey in faith. We worshipped remotely, then in the beauty of the prayer garden amphitheater, then in our sanctuary, then again we worshipped remotely. Being bold Minnesotans, we gathered to celebrate the birth of Jesus in the blistering cold. However, we were warmed by the fire and the Spirit among us as we gathered on Faith's front lawn to sing our welcome to the newborn king. Now we gather again in our sanctuary and offer our thanks and praise in worship to the one who carried the burden of our sin and selfishness on Calvary's cross, and then rose on the third day so we might receive the promise of everlasting life.

Isaiah tells us that in our waiting, God is present with in and among us. God comes to wipe away the tears of our grief. God comes to take away the shame of our sin. God comes to us and saves us. We are to rejoice and be glad because, in Christ Jesus, God comes to give us new and abundant life! The Apostle Paul explains it this way, "So if anyone is in Christ, there is a new creation: everything old has passed away; see, everything has become new!" 2 Corinthians 5:17.

Friends, our celebration of Easter was a bit different than normal last year. (I realize that is an understatement.) I also know that our celebration of Easter will be a bit different than normal this year. But I believe that in the midst of all that is happening around us, we can rejoice and be glad because, in Christ, we are a new creation. Everything old passes away, our sorrow, our loss, our disappointments, and our disrupted lives. Everything becomes new, our lives, our relationships, our joys, our very selves.

I want to thank you for being partners with one another on this journey of faith. This past year you have exemplified what it means to live out the great commandment to love God and love our neighbors. You have lived the promise of 1 Corinthians 13:7 -8 "Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. Love never ends." As we prepare to celebrate Christ's resurrection, "Let us be glad and rejoice in his salvation!"

Property Updates

Hello everyone, one more blast from old man winter is now in the books. Hard to imagine that a couple of weeks ago we had record high temps. Those temperatures will return as we watch spring come raining down on us. Opportunities abound with a need for individuals to join our mowing teams and flower management crew. It is relatively easy, and you get to set your own schedule bound only by how fast the grass is growing and the week or weeks when it is your turn to mow, weed or seed. Faith will furnish the mowers and other tools, or you can bring your own if that fits you better. Specifically, we are looking for a number of individuals to mow the lawns. **Simply go to fatihspicer.org and click on sign up to**

get on the team! In addition, we are also looking for someone or a team to manage the flower beds by the church and in the Columbarium.

Over the past several years Anita Lewison has stepped up to the task however she wishes to allow someone else's green thumb a chance to plant some seeds and nurture the shrubs and perennials that currently are there. Thanks, Anita, for sharing your talents with us. We are also needing to assemble a volunteer team of about 4 or 5 people to help with some siding work on the roof. Qualifications would include being able to work at heights and on ladders, along with being able to bend at the waist and use a hammer or screw gun. It would involve at most 4 or 5 hours once the weather turns nicer.

There will also be other volunteer opportunities for one-time problem-solving solutions as we move towards summer. The Property Team is considering realigning how the water is delivered to the wash spigots by the Community Garden. We also have a number of other items on our short and long range plans including sprinkler enhancements, lawn repairs and reseeding, tree replacement in the Columbarium, fixing some loose pavers and landscape blocks, etc. Having volunteers help with these tasks allows us to redirect our limited budget dollars to those tasks that are out of our wheelhouse or capability to complete. If you have talents or skillsets that we are unaware (we know that is often the case) please contact the office and let us know. I am thinking specifically about plumbers, electricians, landscape designers, HVAC repairs or engineers along with the more typical jack of all trades that are happy with a hammer, drill, shovel or paint brush.
