### **A WORD FROM PASTOR: EASTER FOR YOU!**

As I work with the staff to review and plan for our first Easter together, I want to invite you into the spirituality of Holy Week and the Great Three Days. Holy Week starts with movement! The waving of the palms, the traveling around the sanctuary, the singing of our souls grounds us in the reality of our bodies active in our worship, prayer, and praise.

Christian people should not disassociate themselves from our bodies as we worship. We believe in the Incarnation - God in the flesh! We believe in the resurrection of the body. We believe Jesus faced real physical death with all the terrors connected to dying. On Maundy Thursday we experience Jesus calling us to "love as I have loved you" and physically showing us what that might mean. On Good Friday we see and experience him carrying the cross and we pray with bowed bodies facing him.

In similar ways we experience the disciples seeing the heavy stone rolled away and their surprise and terror even as they try to find him. They cry out "What happened to his body?" The reply is "He is risen. He is not here. Just as he told you." We believe in physical resurrection...because when they saw him...and tried to hold him...his scars told them he was real.

Our worship is physical and not just a mental exercise. If you allow your bodies to be present and partake in Jesus' story perhaps you will come to believe as well with all the saints! God be with You!
