



As a deer longs for flowing streams, so my soul longs for you, O God. My soul thirsts for God, for the living God.
Psalm 42:1-2

As I share these thoughts, the temperature in Spicer has just hit 90 degrees and the humidity is for lack of a better word, tropical. It is one of those days when the best sort of relief is to soak your feet in a cool lake or stream.

There are times in our journey of faith when we may feel similar to how we feel on hot muggy days. Our faith can seem tired and listless, worn down by troubles and worries which we cannot control. In times like these, we find ourselves longing for God and thirsting for the refreshment of God's presence in our lives. We may thirst to be understood, even as we thirst to understand. We may thirst to be forgiven, even as others seek forgiveness from us. We may thirst to belong, even when we find ourselves closing the doors to others.

So what should we do with our thirsty souls and our longing for spiritual refreshment? I believe the first thing we should do is listen to God's invitation for us to come to God. Isaiah proclaims these words of God to the spiritually parched exiles. "Ho, everyone who thirsts, come to the waters; and you that have no money, come, buy and eat! Come, buy wine and milk without money and without price." (Isaiah 55:1) This invitation is extended to all who thirst, all who long for understanding, mercy, forgiveness, and grace. God promises to be an everlasting fountain, flowing with abundant life and joy. And all we have to do is come to the waters of life, to be refreshed and renewed.

The gospel writer John tells the story of the Samaritan woman who comes to the well in the heat of the day to draw water. She happened to encounter Jesus at that well and he promised her that he would give her water that would never leave her thirsty. "The water that I will give will become in them a spring of water gushing up to eternal life." (John 4:14) This is what happens when we are drawn to the refreshing grace of Christ. Our thirsts are satisfied, our souls are refreshed. It is like a cool dip in the lake on a hot day.

Thanks Scott Guptill for fixing sheet rock nicks and repainting and the Parish Arts Team for the nice color selection. Looks outstanding. We continue to embrace the volunteer teams as much as we can. While we don't want to take profits from our local contractors we also try to be good stewards of your monetary contributions. One more thing that it would be nice would be to have a small team of volunteers for minor plumbing repairs. If you fit this bill please let the office know and we will keep your name on a list to fix a leaky sink or toilet etc. There have been some questions about the tasks on the opportunity to serve cards. We need to install a couple of short sections of drainage tile to prevent some erosion behind the church. It will take some hand shovel work but it is in the shade. This will take a bit of time to work through but it is an important part of properly managing our church facility and grounds. Thanks to all our volunteers and donations. They always help. 
