# A WORD FROM PASTOR TIM:

# What does Advent mean for us?

"O that you would tear open the heavens and come down, so that the mountains would quake at your presence — When you did awesome deeds that we did not expect, you came down, the mountains quaked at your presence. Yet, O LORD, you are our Father; we are the clay, and you are our potter; we are all the work of your hand." (Isaiah 64)

These are the evocative words we hear as Advent starts. "Tear the heavens open and come down!" "O Lord, you are our Father; we are the clay, and you are our potter." What kind of prayers lead us to these words? The people are displaced and worn down. They are struggling to connect to their God. Their sins have led their relationship with God astray. Now they pray for God's coming (Advent).

Advent is a preparatory time where the fullness of our lives is considered. Our hurts, our pain, our desires for the future and our relationship with God strung together in bodily prayer. In Advent, our prayers are not wispy. They are not light or soft. They strike a chord at the discord in our lives and in the world and say, "Lord come down!" "Tear the heavens open and come down!"

Advent, (God's coming), is not about our control. It is about God doing something new. "When you did awesome deeds that we did not expect, you came down!" This is the context of John's fiery speech and blessed Mary's unexpected pregnancy. The control we thought we had is punctured by God's movement toward us. Watch for it!




