Immediately [Jesus] made the disciples get into the boat and go on ahead to the other side, while he dismissed the crowds. And after he had dismissed the crowds, he went up the mountain by himself to pray. When evening came, he was there alone, but by this time the boat, battered by the waves, was far from the land, for the wind was against them. And early in the morning he came walking toward them on the sea. But when the disciples saw him walking on the sea, they were terrified, saying, "It is a ghost!" And they cried out in fear. But immediately Jesus spoke to them and said, "Take heart, it is I; do not be afraid." Peter answered him, "Lord, if it is you, command me to come to you on the water." He said, "Come." So Peter got out of the boat, started walking on the water, and came toward Jesus. But when he noticed the strong wind, he became frightened, and beginning to sink, he cried out, "Lord, save me!" Jesus immediately reached out his hand and caught him, saying to him, "You of little faith, why did you doubt?" When they got into the boat, the wind ceased. And those in the boat worshiped him, saying, "Truly you are the Son of God." (Matthew 14:22-33)

I am sure we are all familiar with this well-known scene of Jesus walking on the water, and Peter attempting to do the same. For most of us today, if we imagine trying to walk along the surface of a body of water, the law of gravity might come to mind and, unless we're talking about February in Minnesota, it's just not possible.

But gravity wasn't what came to the minds of the disciples as they saw their Lord walking across the water to them. It wasn't that Jesus was defying gravity, but that he was so in command of the water, he could walk across it.

In biblical times, the sea represented the very forces of chaos -- barely kept at bay by the grace of God, but constantly threatening all the same. In ancient religions that worshiped multiple gods, the god of the sea was also the god of chaos, and understandably so. Oceans are inconceivably massive and have sunk thousands of ships, many far bigger than our church building. The sea essentially controls the weather, producing hurricanes and tsunamis that have all but completely wiped out entire communities of civilization. The ocean is true chaos, and we humans -- even with our history and our knowledge and all of our technological advancements -- we are powerless to control the sea. But God can. God has the power to control even this most massive, chaotic piece of nature.

And if Jesus was there with the disciples on the stormy sea, immediately calming their fears that they were seeing a ghost, and immediately reaching out to pull Peter to safety when he began to sink, then surely Jesus is also with us in our own chaos and storms of life; and not just there with us, but rescuing us when we begin to sink. Thanks be to our saving, life-giving God.





It is a bit of a breezy day today as I write this article for the first time in 2020. With the breeze comes drifting snow but your volunteer team is hard at it making sure the sidewalks are clear. Be patient, walk carefully and thank them as you go about your day. Better yet, grab a shovel and pitch in if you are able. Thanks to everyone who helps make the facility inviting and run smoothly. Things don't get done without you. That goes for the entire life of the



church. So what is going on this month besides the every present snow and ice. Scott Guptill has touched up and painted the area behind the choir where things are stored. Please be careful when moving items in and out of that area. The final LED parking lot lights are being made. We have been working diligently on the budget for the coming year. The Property Team believes firmly that there needs to be additional dollars set aside for larger scale repairs such as parking lot crack sealing, power equipment depreciation, rubber roof repairs and yes even ongoing maintenance. Just as you cannot defer oil changes on your automobile you cannot also defer maintenance on the church facility. More details on this will occur in the Annual Report so look for that as well. Lastly one thing that we are discussing is a power walk behind broom for clearing sidewalks. Works quickly for narrow areas but more importantly it gets all the snow off. We are working on arranging a demonstration to see how well they actually work since they are expensive. Please read your annual report and ask questions about the budget. Thanks!

January 2020 Updates

After the busy holiday season, the staff has finally been able to settle in here at The Link and figure out exactly what kind of impact was made to local families throughout 2019. Looking back at the past year, it is humbling to see all of the generous donations and volunteer support that have made it possible to serve those who need it the most. We thought now would be a great time to share some numbers with YOU, The Link, so that you can see just how your support has made a difference to so many in the community.

Food Pantry

The Food Pantry is growing and it's getting difficult to keep the shelves full!

In 2018, The Link distributed 30,085 pounds of food to 589 families. And now, in 2019, The Link distributed over 43,000 pounds of food to 804 households, which included 1,281 adults, 791 children and 179 seniors. 2019 brought in 13,304 pounds or 6.65 tons of donated food from generous individuals, families, churches, businesses and the NL-S School District.

Household Exchange, Christmas Joy and Holiday Food Baskets
