"As the rain and the snow come down from heaven, and do not return to it without watering the earth and making it bud and flourish, so that it yields seed for the sower and bread for the eater, so is my word that goes out from my mouth: It will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it." Isaiah 55:10-11

It is the New Year! There is snow on the ground, the lakes are frozen and winter has set in here in West Central Minnesota. Sometimes when we are blowing snow or complaining about the cold, we need to remind ourselves that there is a purpose for such things. Underneath the snow creation rests and when it does melt, and it will, the soil will soak up the water and share it with the grass of the fields, the trees of the woods, and provide refreshment for the animals which awake from their hibernation. It will happen just as it should.

God has expectations of how things should be. In Isaiah, God reminds us that there is an expectation that the Word of God, which flows from God's own mouth, will accomplish and achieve the purpose for which it is sent. That is what makes God's Word a living Word. It is proclaimed, taught, sung, painted, shared and lived, and it accomplishes the many purposes for which God sends it. This living Word is powerful, it builds up, encourages, comforts, soothes, celebrates, corrects, guides, breaks down barriers, warns, blesses, and brings good news. This is just a partial list of what God's Word does in the world and in the life of God's good creation.

So, if this Word of God, this living Word, packs so much potential, isn't it an incredible thing that God would give it to us? Think for a moment, that God's powerful Word, is placed upon our lips and in our hearts, and it flows out of us in such incredibly beautiful and creative ways. And in our sharing of his Word in worship, in teaching, in our daily interactions and relationships with others, God's Word accomplishes so many purposes.

As people of faith, we are encouraged to share this living Word. We are invited to learn it, to love it, and to live it. We are called and invited to bring God's living Word into God's living world where people are eagerly waiting to hear its Good News. We all can play a part in what the living Word can and does accomplish. We can do this by first, letting the Word of God dwell within us. Open your Bibles, read and listen to what God is saying about his love for you and for the world. Search the scriptures with friends and neighbors in a Bible study, discuss and share with one another what God's living Word means to you. Then share God's Word, engage in faith conversations, offer God's Word of comfort, hope and peace to a struggling friend or neighbor. And live out the promise of God's living Word, as you are gracious, forgiving and merciful to others. Remember, that God's Word will never return empty, it will accomplish all that God proposes!

- Thank you to Louise and Carter Stenberg who hosted the Church Council for the December potluck and meeting. Discussion around meeting our Mission Plan for 2019 was favorable, and if the trend continues through December, we will finish the year strong.
- The family of George Couleur has given Faith a gift of \$22,095. According to our major gift policy, 10% of this gift goes to benevolence. The council voted to give that amount to Green Lake Lutheran Ministries. 40% of the gift will be deposited in our General Endowment Fund to be distributed according to the parameters of the Endowment Fund. The remaining 50% can be distributed as the council determines. We are seeking input from the congregation on this distribution. A current need is for extra help with Seeds and Sprouts on Wednesday evenings. We voted to fund that, not to exceed \$1,000 through May. Another suggestion was to use a portion of the gift to enhance our music program, possibly purchasing a small set of handbells. If you have suggestions, please talk to one of the pastors, or one of the members of the council.
- Praise and Play Preschool is looking at the option of offering a summer program for preschool and school-age children. If you would like to offer your input, please complete the survey on the Faith Lutheran Church or Praise and Play Preschool Facebook page or the website, faithspicer.org.







The year is drawing to a rapid close. Seems like yesterday that 2019 had just begun with heavy snow and cold weather. Well actually that was just last month as well. A quick update on what is happening now. A complete report will be in the Annual Report. We have a new snow plowing contractor for the parking lots themselves. As always, there will be some growing pains as we all adapt to the idiosyncrasies of when to plow or not. Normally we do not plow if there is 2 inches of snow or less. This is done as a cost saving measure but it brings with it certain perils, not the least of which is snow inside your loafers. Were the budget more flush, we would opt to plow more often. Paul Haney, our custodian, does the entrances early in the morning and the rest of sidewalks are completed by volunteers. Thanks Paul and the Snow Teams for doing that task. If you see a buildup of snow don't hesitate to grab a shovel from one of the entrances and remove the offending snow drift. Everyone will appreci-

Brian Gieseke and I installed several new LED parking lot lights which brighten those areas quite well. Since ordering those lights, several more have expired so we are ordering enough to replace the balance before they too burn out. These are not cheap, costing about \$650 each but should operate more efficiently and be longer lived as well. The light seems to be brighter as well. Thanks Brian for your help and Dave Mickelson at Willmar Forklift for the use of the scissors lift. Thanks also to those who have contributed dollars for the lights.

Another major expense this month was roofing repairs. This was completed prior to the snowfall. West Central Roofing patched several holes that we discovered in the flat roof. They also repaired some seams that were getting ready to

leak. Hopefully this resolves some of the leak issues that have plagued us in the past. Being proactive with repairs and maintenance helps to prevent damage from occurring and expenses from multiplying. We cannot do that without your help both as volunteers and monetarily. Next month you will get a chance to see the proposed budget. I encourage you to review the property proposal carefully and know what is included. Ask questions to discover where the expenditures that you are asked to approve are being made, and then follow through with your stewardship. We are all in this together. Enough for now. Happy New Year to all.


