One of the topics discussed at the May Council meeting was the Strategic Visioning to increase congregation involvement and engagement. A few of the points mentioned were the: rebooting of the visiting ministry teams; youth ministry team including parental involvement; Mission Resource Team (MRT) commitment including attendance at off site meetings; and the Communion retreat as well as Communion for beginners.

Future plans and needs for strategic visioning include: a middle school youth mission trip (part of the basket auction funds will support this ministry); increased need for small group leaders and mentors, supporting longer-term student-mentor relationships; the Faith Book of Wisdom project; and opportunities for musicians offering special music.

Faith council is looking for a few volunteers who might be interested in reviewing the bi-laws and constitution of Faith Lutheran. This task is planned for biennial review.



- 10) Fill out the forms by clicking "Open Forms" - these include Medical, Permissions, and T-Shirt Size and Camper Information
- 11) Choose a Payment Option - *if you would like to apply for a camper or church scholarship, select "Pay later" at this time*

Community Garden


The garden is tilled and people are already planting! Plots are still available, just \$25.
