At Baptism, after the newly baptized is washed with the life giving waters in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit, the sign of the cross is traced upon the baptized forehead and this or a similar promise is spoken, "Child of God, in baptism you have been marked with the cross of Christ and sealed with the promised Holy Spirit." At the end of our earthly journey, the service often begins with these words written by the Apostle Paul, "Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? Therefore we have been buried with him by baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life. For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we will certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his." (Romans 6:3-5) The cross traced on our forehead at baptism links us to the promise of life and resurrection after we have died. As Christians we are cross-marked, and called to carry the cross all of our days as we walk in faith.

During this season of Lent, each of us is invited to see the crosses we bear on our journey. We are also to see the cross from a variety of points of view, because at various times in our lives the cross can mean something different. In our worship on Wednesday evenings and Sunday mornings, we are invited to focus our attention on the ways the cross speaks to our lives, so that we might see the cross of Jesus is always present in the midst of our life as the Body of Christ and on our individual journeys.

To enhance our experience of the cross in this season of Lent, we will participate in a congregational art project where we will create our own mosaic crosses that will be hung on our sanctuary windows. Much like the pieces of a mosaic, the cross speaks to our lives in varied ways. In the creation of our own mosaics, we may discover how the cross speaks to our sorrows, griefs, joys, expectations, fears, faith, and so much more. In addition to this project, during our Wednesday evening worship, we will pause to pray around the cross, where we may offer our sorrows, griefs, joys, expectations, fears, faith and so much more to the one who bore the cross for us.

During the season of Lent, I encourage you to extend an invitation to a friend, neighbor, acquaintance, enemy, or stranger to join us in worship as we "See the Cross" of Jesus which stands before us on our journey of faith.

A Cottage Meeting is a gathering of 12-16 members of the congregation, preferably in someone's home, that will allow time to thank members for their engagement in the life of our congregation, to ask questions about our shared ministry, and to invite their deeper participation in the life of the body of Christ at Faith Lutheran Church. Cottage Meetings are usually 60 to 75 minutes long.

#### WHY SHOULD WE INVEST OUR TIME IN COTTAGE MEETINGS?

People in a congregation want to be heard and when they feel listened to, they are more likely to invest in and deepen their participation in the life of the congregation. Cottage Meetings help assess the spirit of the congregation and provide valuable insight into what is working, what is in need of, change, and what we should grow, hold, or fold.

#### **GOALS**

- ⇒ Celebrate the good things surrounding our life together as a congregation
- ⇒ Listen to and record concerns about the effectiveness of our ministry
- ⇒ Engage participants in conversations of discernment about our current ministry and what might best serve Faith in the future
- ⇒ Encourage members to discover their duties and delights in how we accomplish our ministry

- ⇒ Host a Cottage Meeting in your home
- ⇒ Attend the Cottage Meeting to which you are invited
- ⇒ Volunteer to be part of the Cottage Meeting team



# Praise + Play Preschool - March 2020



# **March Update from The Link**

We have been working hard here at The Link and have some exciting news to share! The Link is now offering a Senior Food Delivery Program for homebound seniors (65+) in the Northern Kandiyohi County area. Knowing that there are many seniors in our community who could benefit from food delivery, be it temporary or longer term, it was time to get something going. a compiled list, we will pack up and deliver the requested food. If you or someone you know could utilize this service or if you would like more information on what it entails, please reach out to us.

The Link has continued to see an increase in households coming through the Food Pantry and has helped numerous families who have come through in need of some financial assistance to help get them back on their feet. The assistance given helped pay everything from medical bills, transportation costs and utility bills to help with rent and house payments. Each of the families were extremely grateful and are able to move forward with less stress because of the help they received.

Please remember that Minnesota FoodShare Month begins March 1 and runs through April 12. Minnesota FoodShare began in 1982 with a campaign to restock food shelves in the 7-county Twin Cities Metro Area. The effort was so successful and the need was so evident, the March campaign became a statewide program. During the 2019 March Campaign, more than \$8 million dollars and over 5.1 million pounds of food shelf items were raised by Minnesota food shelves and Minnesota FoodShare.

Minnesota FoodShare envisions a future where all Minnesotans have access to healthy food and no one struggles with food insecurity. The March campaign addresses these issues directly and we invite you to join our efforts and advocate for long-term solutions to food insecurity and poverty in our communities.
