Faith Book of Wisdom

A few months ago, Pastor Todd and I were approached by one of our members, Ron Strom. He had been inspired by one of our Feast sermons that focused on the Books of Wisdom in the bible, and he wanted to invite our congregation to come up with our own Faith Book of Wisdom.

What's unique about the Books of Wisdom in the bible (Job, Proverbs, Ecclesiastes, Song of Solomon, and some of the Psalms) is that they are expressions and experiences of the faith of everyday people. The authors didn't follow any rules for how to write about their faith, and they weren't reciting history, but simply writing from their heart about their own personal faith. These writings capture some of the most beautiful and poignant expressions of everyday faith life, and I would encourage you to read through them sometime if you haven't had the opportunity before.

We were very excited about Ron's idea of our church creating our own collection of faith experiences, and we would like to invite everyone to participate! The rules are verv simple:

1. Submissions should be no longer than one page in length.

2. Write about a personal reflection regarding your faith -- the style can be poetry, a story/narrative, abstract, stream-of-consciousness, etc.

3. You may submit your written work in any form: handwritten (mail to church or turn in at Welcome Center), typed (mail/Welcome Center), emailed seywarda@faithspicer.org, or Facebook message (Faith page).

4. One entry per person.

Submissions must be turned in by August 1st. At that time, we will put together all the writings into a booklet available to everyone. I would love for this to be something we do each year, so that over time we collect several editions of Faith's Books of Wisdom. Again, this is an invitation for people of all ages in our congregation. I really hope you will consider participating in this, because it will be such a neat expression of faith for our church. I for one can't wait to see where this project takes us!
