During the time of the offering at Faith, a slide goes up on the projection screen that says "Tithes and Offerings." As your interim. I don't know who puts that slide there. But I wonder how many folks actually sit down and determine what forwarding 10% or more of their treasures would mean for their family. Further, I wonder how many let go of that determined amount (tithe) and forward it to support the mission of Faith Lutheran.

Perhaps we can learn from scripture. As for those who in the present age are rich, command them not to be haughty, or to set their hopes on the uncertainty of riches, but rather on God who richly provides us with everything for our enjoyment.¹⁸ They are to do good, to be rich in good works, generous, and ready to share, ¹⁹ thus storing up...the treasure of a good foundation for the future, so that they may take hold of the life that really is life. In October 2021, 3 months postpartum, Bri was treated for what was believed to be an internal hemorrhoid stemming from pregnancy. At 34 years old, Bri was diagnosed with Stage-3 Colorectal Cancer. Bri began doctoring at the Mayo Clinic and after several appointments and genetic testing, it was found out that

she has Lynch Syndrome, which makes her high risk for brain, small bowel, stomach, uterine, colorectal, and skin cancer. Since January, Bri has been traveling to and from Rochester to manage her condition. At this time, it is unknown if Bri will need surgery to remove the tumor; however, after she finishes her treatment for colorectal cancer, she will undergo preventive surgeries to decrease the chances of uterine and ovarian cancer. This will be a lifelong battle for Bri, but she is up for the fight.
