

Then Jesus looked at his disciples and said, "Blessed are you who are poor...Blessed are you who are hungry now... Blessed are you who weep now...Blessed are you when people hate you, and when they exclude you, revile you, and defame you on account of the Son of Man..." Luke 6:20-22

Dear Partners on the Journey,

These words of blessing Jesus speaks in Luke's gospel seem real and concrete. Un-like the beatitudes of Matthew's gospel which seem to speak of others, "those who are poor, hungry, in grief and persecuted" Luke has Jesus taking a direct form of address, almost as if he is speaking through the centuries and across boarders and distant lands and speaking to us. "Blessed are you..." Jesus says directly to us, when we find ourselves impoverished, hungry, grieving and persecuted. Jesus' blessing in Luke are real time blessings, things we need to hear now, in the moment of our poverty, hunger, grief, and exclusion.

The final month of the church year, the month of November begins on All Saints Sunday, as we are assured of the blessed presence of Jesus' love and grace with us in our direst times of need. These blessings are not for "those people", rather they are here and now blessings for you and me. On the final Sunday of November, Christ the King Sunday, Luke again has Jesus speaking immediate blessings even as he hangs between two criminals on the cross. When one of the thieves says, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom." Jesus replies, "Truly I tell you, to-day you will be with me in Paradise." (Luke 23:42-43) The promise of the kingdom for the thief is TODAY! The promise of God's blessings come to us, TODAY! There is no waiting, the presence of Jesus, Emmanuel, God with us, is immediate. Abundant blessings of forgiveness, mercy, life, and new life are all around us as we gather as God's people.

In this month of November, I invite you to take note of the presence of God who is with you on your journey. Look to see God's creative presence in the changing of the seasons, as falling leaves give way to falling snow. Feel the redemptive presence of Jesus who enters into your poverty, hunger, grief and isolation, and blesses, feeds, comforts and be-friends you. Experience the presence of the Holy Spirit, who sends you to share the good news of a God who is immediate and present in the lives of God's people. Amen.

# Your Worship Facility Speaks

Hard to imagine it is nearly November but the calendar marches on. Snow is soon going to be on the ground in earnest and will require scraping, shoveling and blowing. We are working with our new snow removal service to make sure the parking areas are plowed timely but also economically. The contract will not authorize commercial plowing until there accumulates at least 2 inches of snow or until severe wind induced drifting prevents reasonable access. This decision will



be made by the Property Manager. Because the most economical method is to pay for actual hours worked we will not plow more space than can be done efficiently and is necessary. In effect we may only open one lot until the snow stops falling and then will plow all of the lots later in the day and then only if it exceeds 2 inches in depth. Please park in the plowed areas whenever possible. All of the sidewalks will be the responsibility of the Snow Shoveling Teams. To be part of this effort get your name in early. The more volunteers the better. Teams will be forming and assignments made by November 1 but extra persons can always be added.

Many thanks to the dozen or so volunteers that showed up on that rainy Saturday for fall clean up day. While we could not get everything done that needed to happen outside we did accomplish what initially appeared to be a monumental task. All the left over blocks and pavers from our construction that had accumulated along the back property line were re-stacked on new pallets and moved to more obscure location to await usage in the footings for the next columbarium foundation which will be installed in the spring. Thanks to all the volunteers that helped with this effort. Speaking of the columbarium, we have a a couple who have stepped up and offered to monitor and control weeds in that area for next season. Thanks to them for doing this. When you see them out there offer to lend a hand and everyone's load will be a little lighter. That is true for any maintenance activity around the entire property. That is all for now.
