A WORD FROM PASTOR TIM **Easter Joy with Moments of Terror!**

Happy Easter!

These words have lifted my spirit many times. We say, "Happy Easter!" with hope and an acknowledgement of Jesus' resurrection unfolding upon God's people over time.

- In Mark's gospel the women "went out and fled from the tomb, for terror and amazement had seized them, and they said nothing to anyone, for they were afraid" (Mark 16).
- In Matthew's gospel "they left the tomb guickly with fear and great joy and ran to tell his disciples. Suddenly Jesus met them and said, 'Greetings!' And they came to him, took hold of his feet, and worshiped him. Then Jesus said to them, 'Do not be afraid; go and tell my brothers and sisters to go to Galilee; there they will see me." (Matthew 28).
- In Luke's gospel the women are met by men in dazzling white, who reminded them of what Jesus told them, "the Son of Man must be handed over to sinners, and be crucified, and on the third day rise again. Then they remembered his words, and returning from the tomb, they told all this to the eleven and to all the rest. But these words seemed to them an idle tale..." (Luke 24).
- Finally in John's gospel, which we heard on Easter morning, Jesus himself speaks Mary's name and tells her to "go to my brothers and say to them, 'I am ascending to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God.' Mary Magdalene went and announced to the disciples, 'I have seen the Lord'" (John 20).

It is a chaotic Easter morning, folks. There are feelings of terror and amazement – words of greeting to 'not be afraid' – and finally a promise of meeting. Easter resurrection must be worked out among the disciples of Jesus! This is an ongoing, lived out experience of 'God with us.' Jesus, the risen one, is going to meet us in new and ongoing ways. Do not be afraid!
