Stir Up!

In Advent, we look for the coming and going of God in our world and wait in expectation for God's work to be done. Interestingly, the Prayer of the Day in Advent all use the phrase "Stir up."

- Advent 1: "Stir up your power, Lord Christ, and come."
- Advent 2: "Stir up our hearts, Lord God, to prepare the way of your only Son."
- Advent 3: "Stir up the wills of your faithful people, Lord God."
- Advent 4: "Stir up your power, Lord Christ, and come."

The word "stir" is connected to the Latin *excita*. We pray for God's power and Lord Jesus to come to the world and God's people again. We also pray for our hearts and wills to be connected to God's coming.

The image I have is the stirring spoon/stick that mixes the drink. Recently, I have been mixing granular powder into my large glass of water after dog walking. I like the extra flavor and electrolytes. I would not like the taste if I did not apply spoon spinning to the bottom of the glass. The powder must become part of the whole. The church must become part of the whole of God's plan otherwise we become ineffectual.

Individually, we pray for God's coming and communally we pray for God's coming. Both are needed to be effectually prepared. We must be "stirred" together. "Please God, stir up our hearts!" Ah...our hearts are stirred to look up, to rejoice, to receive the babe, and celebrate with the angels.

"Stir up our hearts and come!" This is the prayer of the Christian people. Please join me, individually and communally in these prayers! They are God's preparatory gift for us as we wait.
