

### A WORD ABOUT THIS YEAR'S ADVENT JOURNEY:

- Wednesday, December 17: "Sharing God's Word"




### CHRISTMAS POINSETTIAS - ORDER NOW!


### MITTEN TREE AT FAITH - COMING SOON!

## A WORD FROM PASTOR TIM: THINKING OF THE FUTURE!

God's blessing to all!

Whenever December comes, it is hard not to think of Mary - teenager and mother of Jesus. She was already living with pressure - baby and societal pressure. I did not mention Joseph, but it could not have been easy to sort out the relational issues of trust that were present in their engagement. Yikes!

We hear counseling words like "be present – face what you can today – leave tomorrow's worries for another day." I doubt those modern words were present in her reality though...perhaps her thoughts were struck by the cruelty of Roman rule to her people. The road could not have been smooth on her travels to Bethlehem to complete a census.

All these realities - pushing, pulling, growing belly, and tension are part of her life. They are not the only words of reality for Mary though...God also impacts her reality. The angelic messengers, words of promise and hope, and her response affects her reality.

Listen again, "And he came to her and said, 'Greetings, favored one! The Lord is with you.' But she was much perplexed by his words and pondered what sort of greeting this might be. The angel said to her, 'Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. And now, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you will name him Jesus. He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High, and the Lord God will give to him the throne of his ancestor David. He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of his kingdom there will be no end. For nothing will be impossible with God.'

Then Mary said, 'Here am I, the servant of the Lord; let it be with me according to your word.' Then the angel departed from her." (Luke 1)

God is impacting her reality! God is impacting our reality. This is the power of the Christian message. There are so many things going on in the world. There are so many things affecting us. We need God to speak through this mess! Jesus is that "speech" - Word of God made flesh.

You do not need to do more. Let God do the talking! God's speech is filled with hope for you!

## THE GREAT LUTEFISK OPENER - THANK YOU!!!!

Hello everyone.

Just wanted to take a couple of minutes of your time to express our appreciation of everyone's effort in support of the Great Lutefisk Opener. This thanks extends to everyone that dined with us and to all the volunteers. Of the 100 plus people that volunteered directly during the event 27 were youth and another 14 were parents of involved youth. Another 60-70 adults participated in baking bread, rolling lefse, cooking fish, setting tables, preparing and serving what everyone polled said was some of the best lutefisk and meatballs they had eaten and the dessert line and lefse were excellent as well. In addition to those involved directly there were many more people **that donated butter, coffee, flour, treats and most importantly time. To all of you Mange Tusen Takk (Many Thousand Thanks).** Each of you carried out an important role in this major community event. I have visited with a number of the attendees over the past couple of weeks and while they enjoyed the meal what they really remembered was the efficiency and the exuberance that was exhibited by everyone working. One person told me that even though they did not get to eat till later all the workers including the youth were still smiling at the end of the day. Kudos to all the teams for that. A special thank you to Lisa Quam for helping get part of the food orders organized with their suppliers and to Pastor Dan Bowman for helping with the lefse.

As for the numbers here is what we know now. We are confident that slightly over 700 meals were plated which represents a sizeable increase over last year. Most people utilized the waiting time to visit with those they may not have seen since last year and listened to Sharon on the piano. People visited the fish shack from the Son's of Norway from St. Paul and other diners came from Perham and Barnesville, Minneapolis and Sunburg. This was a very successful community event that everyone should be proud to have been a part of.

While we know that it is a lot of work we are already thinking about next year so we hope we can count on many of you to join us again. **Thanks again for helping keep the tradition alive and trying a little lutefisk with your lefse.**
