2025 Ballot Measure to Replace the Common Area Fence

Cherry Park has a GID (General Improvement District) that is responsible for the maintenance, repair, replacement, utilities and upkeep of the common area and fence.

In the short term the GID will work to keep the fence up until it can be replaced, an increasingly expensive job that has the potential to consume the funds currently in the GID account with the City. There is a plan to replace the existing fence, similar to the Homestead neighborhood. The GID would have to get a loan to finance a fence replacement, therefore increasing your property tax. This would require a 2025 ballot measure for this November. The measure would require a 50% plus one vote from the people in Cherry Park.

There will be many informative meetings to discuss the plan, answer any questions so that you are fully informed of the process, options if the ballot measure passes or fails, and to present your input.



IF YOUR DOG POOPS
AND NO ONE IS WATCHING,
YOU STILL NEED TO PICK IT UP.

Recently, a homeowner asked, "if they didn't pay their dues, are they still bound by the covenants?". **The answer is YES**. Although voluntary, we do expect all homeowners to pay annual dues of \$50. Covenants apply to the entire subdivision, whether dues are paid or not.

Quick reminder! Trailers, campers etc cannot be stored in front of a residence for more than three days.

If storage beyond 72 hours is necessary, trailers must be concealed within an enclosed garage, or the rear of the residence, which is concealed from view by a six-foot-high privacy fence. This doesn't mean covering it with a tarp or extending your current 6-foot fence above 6 feet. See section 10 of the covenants* for complete details.

Recreational Vehicles (RV's) are not allowed to be stored onsite or behind a residence. RV's are not considered a primary source of transportation.


April Market Snapshot:
