TOP TIPS TO WINTERIZE YOUR HOME

Here, we've compiled 6 key tips for getting your house ready for winter, in order of importance.

- I. Secure Outdoor Water Sources: Drain and store any garden hoses or sprinklers before the first frost to eliminate the chance that they'll freeze and burst. For hose bibs, shut off the water-supply valve inside your house or basement that feeds the line, then open the outdoor spigot to drain trapped water (if you don't, it can freeze and burst a pipe).
- 2. Protect Indoor Pipes: Insulate your pipes that reside under sinks, in attics and crawl spaces, and any on an exterior wall.
- 3. Service Your Furnace and Chimney: Faulty fireplaces, chimneys, and heating equipment can cause house fires; best to have them serviced and inspected annually.
- 4. Repair Loose Roofing Shingles: have the roof inspected and repaired before it snows. A single cubic foot weighs roughly 20 pounds, which is enough pressure to shift loose shingles and allow water or moisture into your home.
- 5. Clean and Inspect Gutters: Keep your gutters clear to ensure melting snow runs off your roof through downspouts.
- 6. Look for Ailing Tree Limbs: Tend to your trees as dead branches snap easily with snow load which becomes a financial burden and a major safety issue.

Our numbers for the month of September showed that the average closed sales price was down 2% lower than prices at this time last year. The inventory for the month of September was up 10% more than what we saw in September of 2023. Homes median days on market have increased as well. The mortgage companies adjusted interest rates lower in late August in anticipation of the Fed rate cut in September. Many buyers are waiting in hopes of seeing lower rates in the coming months.
