RULES AND REGULATIONS

- I. Hours of operations are from Sunrise to Sunset.
- II. All interments must be approved by RILEY SMITH FUNERAL HOMES LLC D/B/A PERKINS CEMETERY and only RILEY SMITH FUNERAL HOMES LLC D/B/A PERKINS CEMETERY will be allowed to do the opening and closing of the grave and anything other than the burial of human remains is strictly prohibited.
- III. No placement of headstones of any fashion without location being approved by Cemetery.
- IV. The cemetery does not allow stacking of burial vaults unless pre-approved by RILEY SMITH FUNERAL HOMES LLC D/B/A PERKINS CEMETERY
- V. No person may discharge any firearm or have possession of any firearm within the cemetery grounds at any time except for use during military services, Memorial Day observations or use by law enforcement personnel.
- VI. No person may drive any motor vehicle at a speed in excess of five miles per hour within the cemetery and such vehicle must confine their travel to established roadways.
- VII. No person shall disturb the dignity, peace, and quiet of the cemetery by the use of excessive noise or boisterous and unruly conduct within the limits of the cemetery.
- VIII. No planting of permanent foliage, i.e., shrubs and trees. All trees and shrubs not approved by the Cemetery may be removed without notice.
- IX. No removal of dirt from the premises.
- X. Flowers must be in a flower urn, planter, pot, or otherwise removable container. No glass containers allowed.
- XI. Placing of toys, metal framework, wood crosses, shepherd's hooks, ornaments, figurines, solar lights, wind chimes, decorative flags and similar articles upon plots will not be permitted. The Cemetery reserves the right to remove any article deemed unacceptable.
- XII. Flags may be placed on graves on Memorial Day, the Fourth of July, and Veterans Day. Flags are subject to removal by Cemetery beginning five (5) days after the Holiday.

The Rules and Regulations are effective as of January 1, 2026 and are subject to change.
