MARKER REGULATIONS AS OF SEPTEMBER 1, 2025

All markers must be installed by Restlawn Memorial Park at the lot owner's expense.

Delivery fee to the cemetery is \$95.00.**

The setting fee at the present time is .95 cents* per square inch of the total granite.

As of Sept. 1, 2024 an administrative fee of \$175.00 will be required on all markers.**

All markers shall be set at the head of the cemetery plot or plots.

Beginning January 2026 FLAT GRANITE MARKERS with GRANITE VASE are acceptable.

Flat bronze plaque on a granite base. NAME, BIRTH DATE and DEATH DATE must be inscribed on the bronze, any other inscriptions are allowed directly on the granite. If the marker has a vase, it must also be made of bronze and be removable. A minimum of a 2-inch border of granite must extend beyond the bronze on all sides.

INDIVIDUAL MARKERS. An individual marker may be set on each grave, but no individual marker may be set to embrace two or more graves.

**Individual markers must be on a 3- to 4-inch-thick granite base:
no less than 19" x 7" for the bronze on a 24" x 12" granite,
and no larger than 34" x 74" for the bronze on a 38" x 84" granite.**

**Infant's markers in Babyland must be on a 3- to 4-inch-thick granite base:
no less than 11" x 3" for the bronze on a 15" x 7" granite,
and no larger than 10" x 20" for the bronze on a 14" x 24" granite.**

COMPANION MARKERS. No companion marker may be set to embrace more than two plots. No more than two individual inscriptions may be used on any marker unless authorized by the Cemetery.

**Companion markers must be on a 3- to 4-inch-thick granite base:
no less than 32" x 8" for the bronze on a 36" x 14" granite,
and no larger than 60" x 20" for the bronze on a 64" x 24" granite.**
