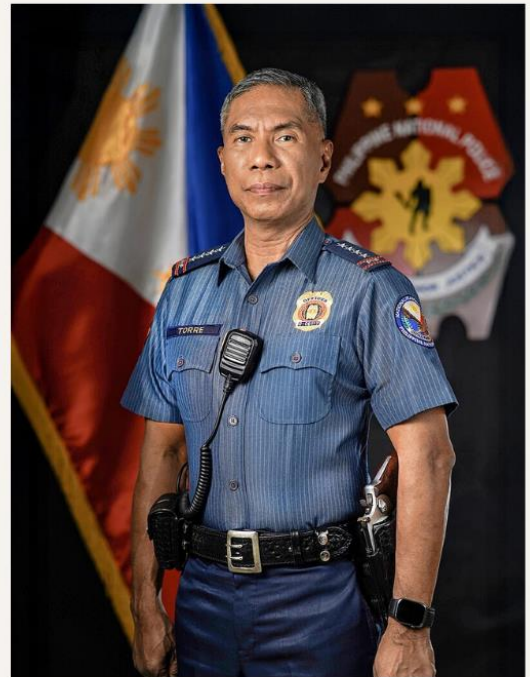



Trustee Barretto informed the Presiding Officer that the Notice of Meeting for the AGMM was sent through e-mails, published in Viber GCs, FB page, and the Lakan MBI website. Together with the notice, copies of the minutes of the previous meeting, audited financial statements, and documents and reports for approval were also sent to them so that could they could adequately be informed and intelligently participate in the proceedings. He further reported that there were sufficient attendees of the meeting, hence there was a quorum for the 2024 AGMM.

Trustee Ferdinand M. Garay, President, presented the accomplishments and updates on the performance of the Association for the period June 2023 to July 2024.

ON OPERATIONS –

a) Membership – There are at present, 1,562 active members of the Lakan MBI, broken down as follows: PNPA cadets, 880; active PNP BJMP and BFP personnel, 519; retired members, 117; and associate members, 46.

b) PNPA Graduates vs Lakan MBI Members – Based on records, there are already Seven Thousand Four Hundred Seventy-Five (7,475) graduates of the PNPA but only One Thousand Five Hundred Sixteen (1,516) are members of the Lakan MBI which translates to only 17% for a very low turnout. Considering the PNPA data that from 2015 to 2024, there were Two Hundred Fourteen (214) PNPA graduates who died but only ten (10) were members, this is a missed opportunity for an organization like the Lakan MBI to assist the families of PNPA graduates who died. There is therefore a need to exert more effort in our

information campaigns to convince more graduates to enroll with the Lakan MBI as members.

c) Accreditation – The PNP Committee on Accreditation for Automatic Deduction (CAAD) renewed last June 20, 2024, the automatic deduction accreditation with the PNP of the Lakan MBI.

d) Approval by the Insurance Commission of LAKAN MBI Amended Basic Life Insurance Product – On December 15, 2023, the Insurance Commission approved our amended Basic Life Insurance Product.

e) Health Maintenance Organization – Out of the 605 Lakan MBI members who are enrolled with the HMO hosted by Lakan MBI, 142 were able to enjoy medical/health benefits for medical consultations, laboratory services, and other out-patient health care.

f) Claims by Beneficiaries – There were three (3) death claims processed by Lakan MBI for the period. The recipients/beneficiaries of the two (2) natural deaths (the late Assoc Guialani and the late PSSupt Felipe) and one (1) accidental death (the late PLTCol Aclan) claims were already settled/paid in the amount of One Million Pesos (P1,000,000.00) each for the natural deaths and Two Million Pesos (P2,000,000.00) for the accidental death. As to medical benefits, medical reimbursement to three (3) Lakan MBI members were granted amounting to Fifty Thousand Pesos (P50,000.00) each. There are two (2) other death benefit claims death benefit claims being processed by the Association as of the moment.

g) Loan Assistance – For the period, six (6) Lakan MBI members were granted loan assistance with an aggregate amount of Five Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (P550,000.00). Three (3) members renewed their loans and the application of one (1) member is being processed.

ADMINISTRATION –

For the period, a total of Three Million Four Hundred Eighty-Six Thousand One Hundred Ten Pesos (P3,486,110.00) was spent on personnel management, remuneration/allowances, meals and travel allowances, and maintenance and operating expenses for the period.

After the report, the Chairman asked if there were no further questions on the President's Report, after which Trustee Bathen moved for the approval of the report which was duly seconded by Trustee Dial, the President's Report was declared approved.

8. Presentation and Acceptance of the Audited Financial Statements by the Treasurer:

The Audited Financial Statements as of December 2023, with comparative figures as of December 2022 presented by Lakan Mario N. Rariza, Jr., Treasurer, as follows:

After deducting liabilities from the total assets, the Fund Balance for 2023 is Nine Million Four Hundred Sixteen Seven Hundred Sixty-Eight (9,416,768.00). With the increase in members (from 1,248 in 2022 to 1,533 in 2023), there was a noted increase in receipts and benefit expenses but the overall financial position of the Association improved. The financial data further disclosed that the Association achieved an excess of receipts over expenses of One Million Three Hundred Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy Pesos (P1,300,770.00).

There being no further questions on the Treasurer's Financial Report, Trustee Dial moved for its adoption, duly seconded by Trustee Bulaong, and the motion was declared approved by the Chairman.

9. Ratification of All Acts and Resolutions Passed by the Board of Trustees for the period July 2022 to June 2023 –

The acts and resolutions passed by the Board of Trustees from July 2023 up to June 2024 were presented for approval and ratification. The Interim Secretary informed the body that copies of said acts and resolutions were sent to the members in advance for their review and consideration. There being no further questions relative to the acts and resolutions passed by the Board of Trustees, the same was duly moved by Trustee Rariza for ratification, duly seconded by Trustee Bathan, and declared by the Presiding Officer as duly approved and ratified.

10. Questions and Answers /Open Forum –

10.1. Question: (Face-to-face/Cadet 1CL CM Bumanglag) Being a member of the Lakan MBI are we automatically enrolled with the HMO?

Answer: Trustee Pres Garay informed the cadets that it is not automatic to become members of the HMO if you are a Lakan MBI member. There is a need to have a separate application for the same since it is an optional product from the Lakan MBI. He further explained that the coverage for the basic membership with Lakan MBI includes medical reimbursements for accidental injuries only.

10.2. Question: (Face-to-face/Cdt 1CI JO Intano) If we are members of the HMO, are our dependents covered by the HMO?

Answer: Trustee Pres Garay informed the cadets that their dependents are not covered by the HMO. He further explained that dependents are only designated as beneficiaries in case of the death of the member.

10.3. Comment: (Online/PMaj FM Suguian II, Class 14) He informed the body that the benefit he derived from his membership with the Lakan MBI had helped him greatly during his recent accident. He further urged those who are non-members to enroll immediately for membership with Lakan MBI. He added that there are PNPA graduates who are inquiring from him regarding the matter but he could not properly answer their questions. He requested that an AVP be made available so that he could help in information dissemination to other Lakans.

10.4. Comment: (Online/PSSupt JU Rivera [Ret], Class 83) He congratulated the Lakan MBI BOT for all the work they have done for the Lakan MBI. He proposed a simple computation to emphasize the importance of the Lakan MBI membership: If you continually contribute for thirty (30) years at ₱18,000.00 per year (1,500.00 per month), you would only contribute a total of ₱540,000.00, but the death benefit is 1M. So, the member still stands to gain in this arrangement. He therefore encouraged the cadets to convince other cadets who are not yet members to enroll with the Lakan MBI now.

10.5. Comment Face-to-face: (PSSupt AP Guialani [Ret], Class 89) shared his experience with being a member of the Lakan MBI. He further compared the benefits derived from Lakan MBI against those other insurance companies offering insurance with law enforcement personnel and he gave the Lakan MBI all the advantages on benefits. 1:03 VLC/10:10 win

III. Introduction of the Guest of Honor & Speaker –

The Guest of Honor and Speaker, Insurance Commissioner Atty Reynaldo A Regalado, was introduced by the BOT Chairman, Trustee Rentoy. He summarized the achievements of Atty Regalado with the POEA as Administrator, Labor Attache in Japan and South Korea, and at the DOLE as Asst Secretary. He also mentioned his academic credentials being a graduate of the UP School of Economics and an alumnus of the UP College of Law.

The Guest of Honor and Speaker was represented by Atty Randy G Serrano, the Deputy Commissioner for Legal Services Group of the Insurance Commission. After acknowledging the presence of the BOT, officers and employees of Lakan MBI, and other guests, he congratulated the Lakan MBI for reaching eight years in the insurance business. He observed that this is a result of the dedication and experience of the BOT in managing the affairs of the Association and the cooperation of the members. He further acknowledged the dedication of men in uniforms and are members of the Lakan MBI for their service to the nation by keeping the peace and order in enforcing the law.

After summarizing the situation the Philippines is in regarding the controversy at the West Philippine Sea where our country and China are engaged in near-skirmishes, he asked if the country is at war. By way of answering the question, he emphasized that we really are at war with poverty, which is the main reason why we need insurance for financial security.

He added that with the membership of the Lakan MBI, the members are insured the future of their families, which is a fitting summary of the Lakan MBI's theme for the year: "Seguridad sa Bawat Hakbang: Alaga sa Kinabukasan". He stressed the importance of HMOs, non-life, accident, and life insurance in our life. He further accentuated the fact that members are co-owners of the association such that he urged the cadets to cascade by heart the benefits of membership with the company to fellow cadets and family members. He cited an example where a Lakambini might require a suitor to become member with the Lakan MBI first before she considers him for reciprocating his proposal.

He urged the members of the BOT to continue delivering the best service to clients, and highlighted the fact that excellent service is the best advertisement. He commended the founders and current leadership of Lakan MBI for a job well done.

IV. Adjournment - There being no other matters to be discussed, the meeting was adjourned by the Presiding Officer at around 11:40 in the morning of the same date.

On behalf of the Board of Trustees of Lakan MBI, I am pleased to present to you, on the occasion the 9th Annual General Membership Meeting (AGMM), a report on the modest accomplishments, activities and updates of our Association for CY 2024 and 2025 before this year's assembly. To wit:

I. OPERATIONS

A. Membership

As of June 2025, the Association's total membership stands at one thousand six hundred ninety-three (1,693), with the majority comprising Active Members at eight hundred four (804), followed by Cadets at seven hundred seven (707), Retired Officers at one hundred nineteen (119), and Associate Members at sixty-three (63).

A. Personnel Management

1. Personnel Hiring and Orientation Training

A new Billing Clerk commenced contractual employment on March 24, 2025, with a six-month on-the-job training.

2. Remunerations and Other Allowance

A Total of One Million Six Hundred Eighty-Eight Thousand Four Hundred Eighty-One Pesos (P1,688,481.00) was disbursed for salaries, bonuses, and 13th-month pay of staff and officers. Consultancy fees amounting to Five Hundred Fifty-Six Thousand One Hundred Forty-Nine Pesos (P556,149.00) were paid to consultants for actuarial services, external auditing requirements, accountancy, and bookkeeping functions. Monthly travel allowances during regular monthly meetings for the Members of the Board of Trustees totaled Two Hundred Fifty-Two Thousand Pesos (P252,000.00)

3. Morale and Welfare

For the period, a total of thirty-seven (37) leaves of absence was granted to Lakan MBI personnel. As support to the staff, a total of One Hundred Ninety-Two Thousand Two Hundred Twenty Pesos (P122,220.00) daily meal and transportation allowance were given. Likewise, a total of One Hundred Ninety-Six Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty Pesos (P196,850.00) in travel expenses were provided to engagements and other similar activities.

B. Maintenance and Operating Expenses

A total of One Hundred Eight Thousand Eight Hundred Twelve Pesos (P108,812.00) was utilized to support expenses incurred in the procurement of meal, snacks, and similar expenses relative to the conduct of meetings and conferences. This includes total provision for the yearly Annual General Membership Meeting (AGMM). Likewise, One Hundred Sixty-One Thousand Twenty-One Pesos (P161,021.00) was spent for payment of utilities (water, electricity, telephone line, internet, office cellphone, zoom subscription, google drive) and Seventy Thousand Five Hundred Fifty-Three Pesos (P70,553.00) were spent for supplies and goods for the office.
