
\*Meeting starts early at 11:15 am, free round of bingo before lunch

#### Ladies,

What warms your heart about Spokes? The smiles of welcome and fabulous women genuinely open to making friends and connecting with others at luncheons and game groups? The opportunity to make a difference in our community, through financial support to non-profits and through direct and hands-on support throughout the year?

Our last meeting offered two beautiful examples of how Spokes offers you the opportunity to help others in our community. At the end of the newsletter, you'll find a picture of members lugging bags of 400+ pillows for heart surgery patients at Advent Hospital. These are cut out, sewn, and stuffed by Spokes members and paid for with donations and from our dues. I spoke with a nurse in the cardiac care unit, and was told that they were being distributed the next day! While the hospital often provides generic heart pillows to patients, the supply chain had broken down and current patients were not receiving them. Spokes to the rescue!

We also connected with a new charity at our last luncheon -- One Purse. Founder Heather Case shared how One Purse helps women break free from cycles of



violence and brokenness, by offering survivors jobs/job skills and scholarships for college tuition or vocational training. When women can achieve financial independence, it strengthens the foundation of freedom for them and

the generations that follow. *One Purse reached out after our meeting to thank members for donating so many wonderful bags for refurbishment by their Dream Studio shop.* If you were unable to attend, you can still help through the **One Beautiful Bag Project.**


