ANNE OF GREEN GABLES
By Lucy Maud Montgomery



Anne of Green Gables is a 1908 novel by Canadian author Lucy Maud Montgomery. Written for all ages, it has been considered a classic children's novels since the mid-20<sup>th</sup> century. Set in the late 19<sup>th</sup> century, the novel recounts the adventures of Anne Shirley, an 11-year-old orphan girl, who is sent by mistake to two middle-aged siblings, Matthew and Marilla Cuthbert, who had originally intended to adopt a boy to help them on their farm in the fictional town of Avonlea in Prince

Edward Island, Canada. Anne is fanciful, imaginative, eager to please, and dramatic. She is also adamant her name should always be spelt with an *e* at the end. The novel recounts how Anne makes her way through life with the Cuthberts, in school, and within the town. Part Tom Sawyer, part Jane Eyre, by the end of Anne of Green Gables, Anne has become the heroine of her own story. Since its publication, *Anne of Green Gables* has been translated into at least 36 languages and has sold more than 50 million copies, making it one of the best-selling books worldwide.


