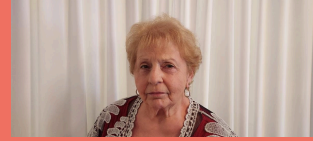
Fostering Kindness - Altamonte Springs - the purpose of this non-profit is to provide meaningful gifts, essential items, and experiences to teens and children in foster care.

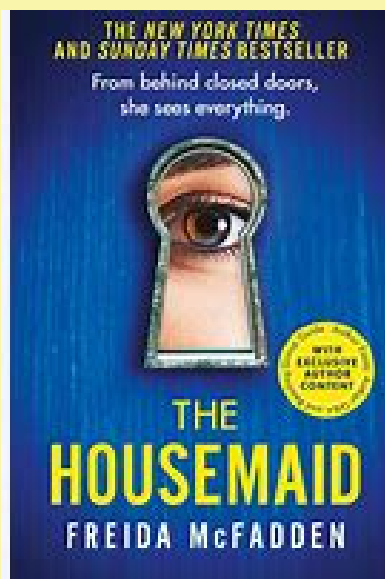
