09/11 –A day to remember and honor the victims of the September 11, 2001, the day when terrorism slaughtered so many in New Your City, the Pentagon, and the Pennsylvania countryside We must NEVER FORGET that the innocent victims of the Sept 11,2001 attack on America did not die in vain. We must remain committed to supporting the young men and women of our armed forces who go in harm's way on our behalf, fighting the war against terrorism.

09/16– POW/MIA *Recognition Day is to* ensure that Americans always remember to stand behind those who serve and to make sure we do everything we can to account for those who have never returned. Efforts to find those men, identify them and bring them home are constant. No man left behind We will hold a service in honor of the MIA/POWS who have not yet made it home on Friday Sept 16th, Breakfast at 10:30AM. Service at 11:30AM

PACT ACT – On a more joyous note, finally this bill passed the House and the Senate and was signed into law by the President. It was a little questionable when having passed both the house and senate, it returned after clarifications were made. And then the unthinkable happened. It passed the house but not the Senate. The American Legion reached out to its members and implored them to contact their senators to pass the bill; and they did and it passed with Florida leading the charge. Florida Legionnaires flooded the offices of Senator Rubio and Senator Scott with over 4,728 messages to pass the PACT Act. Not only is this the highest number of messages sent by a Department, but also calculates as the highest number of engaged Legionnaires at 4.59%. Congratulations, and thank you for your advocacy for veterans!






