Commander's Corner

I have been asked a few times about the history of our Post and with the anniversary of the grand opening of our Post home coming up in April, this seems like a good opportunity to share our Post story.

In January 1992, the Citrus County Chronicle ran an article that a new American Legion Post was being formed to serve veterans in the Homosassa, Chassahowitzka and Lecanto area. The new Post, #166, was named in honor of a local man from Lecanto, Marine WO4 Arnold Vern Allen (01/22/1915 - 09/16/1991).

The Post was issued a temporary charter on March 30, 1992, and the actual charter was presented to the Post on February 17, 1993, with charter membership of 66 Legionnaire members.

The first official meeting was held at the recreation center in Crystal Oaks on SR 44. Without a Post home, the meetings were held at many venues over the years, including the Lions Club, Homosassa VFW, several restaurants, the Elks, and the Eagles.

The Post was very successful at first and even had an Honor Guard. But after a few years, membership began to decline due to members getting older and others who were tired of not having a Post home. By 2007, the Post membership had shrunk to just twelve members and was in danger of losing its Charter.

The new Commander, with help from the District, was successful in slowly growing membership again and slowly added the Legion Family. First was the Auxiliary who received their charted in 2015 followed by The Sons of the American Legion and the American Legion Riders in in 2017.

And finally on February 1, 2019, the Post was able to sign a lease on their first home and the Post held an opening celebration on April 20th, 2019.

Today we have 297 American Legion members, 180 Auxiliary members, 75 SAL members and 22 American Legion Riders. And the Post is growing in membership every day.

Space is tight at times, but with the support of our members we are working hard to grow our Building Fund. To all of you who have attended a monthly Sunday dinner or participated in Tuesday night desserts, 50/50 raffles, the Bonz Games, and the many other activities that support the Fund, and to those who make all of it possible, I extend a sincere Thank You! With everyone's help, I know we will accomplish the goal!




