May is Military Appreciation Month!

VE Day (May 8): Victory in Europe Day - the day that Germany surrendered to its Allies in World War II **Armed Forces Day** (May 18): This is the day set aside to honor the men and women who are currently serving in the United States military.

Memorial Day (May 26): Always the last Monday of May, this day is set aside to honor the more than 1 million men and women who have lost their lives defending America beginning with the Revolutionary War.




