

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS

THAT I, AUGUST J. PETERSEN, widower, of Braintree, Norfolk County, Massachusetts, being of full age and of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make, publish and declare this present instrument as and for my last will and testament, hereby revoking and making null and void any and all former wills and testaments by me at any time heretofore made.

ARTICLE FIRST: I direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid as soon as conveniently may be after the time of my decease.

ARTICLE SECOND: I give and bequeath to MRS. THOMAS KILLMAN of 231 Washington Street, Weymouth, Massachusetts, if she shall survive me, the sum of Seven hundred (\$700.00) dollars.

ARTICLE THIRD: I give and bequeath to HJALMAR B. HANSON, 55 Free Street, Hingham, Massachusetts, or his widow, if he shall not survive me, the sum of One thousand (\$1000.00) dollars.

ARTICLE FOURTH: I give and bequeath to DELTA LODGE A.F. & A.M. of said Braintree, the sum of Five hundred (\$500.00) dollars.

ARTICLE FIFTH: I give and bequeath to MRS. ELLEN CARMINATI, wife of Robert Carminati, of 76 Washington Square South, New York City, the sum of Five hundred (\$500.00) dollars.

ARTICLE SIXTH: I give and bequeath to MRS. ALIDA R. BEEDE, of 507 Pamela Street, Sulphur, Louisiana, the sum of Five hundred (\$500.00) dollars. It is my intention that this gift shall be for the benefit of her grandson David, now of Toronto, Canada, whose name and address are unknown to me, and I therefore request that she give it to him.

ARTICLE SEVENTH: I give and bequeath to my present housekeeper, MRS. SARAH LEONARD, the sum of Two thousand (\$2000.00) dollars, and any household furnishings or effects which she may select, if she is still in my employ at the time of my death, or at such time as I may cease to need a housekeeper.

ARTICLE EIGHTH: I give, devise and bequeath all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, real, personal or mixed of which I shall die seized or possessed, to the TOWN OF BRAINTREE, a municipal corporation, but in trust nevertheless for the following purposes:

The principal and any accumulated income is to be used for the construction of a swimming pool and necessary incidental buildings and equipment on Watson Park, with the said swimming pool to be named "THE PETERSEN MEMORIAL POOL", and to be identified as such by a suitable plaque indicating that it was provided as a memorial to Sadie A. Petersen and Captain August J. Petersen.

In the event that the said fund with any addition which the Town may make by appropriation is insufficient for the purpose, the income shall be allowed to accumulate and be added to the principal until the fund, together with any such addition, is sufficient for the purpose.

When the Town does proceed under the above provision to construct said Pool and incidental facilities, the work shall

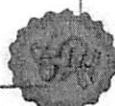
be done under the direction of a committee of three members, one of whom shall be George H. Gerrior, Jr. if living, willing and able to serve, with a substitute for him if necessary, and two others to be appointed by the Moderator, but no contract is to be let nor payment made except with the approval of said Gerrior if he serves on said committee.

Upon the completion of the construction of the Pool and incidental facilities they shall be maintained by and under the control of the Park and Recreation Board of the Town of Braintree, or its successor.

ARTICLE NINTH: I nominate and appoint GEORGE H. GERRIOR, JR., 34 Edgell Road, East Braintree, Massachusetts, as Executor of this my will and testament, and request that he be not required to furnish any surety upon his official bond as such Executor.
