

Aircraft Emergency/Action Plan

If there is an injury possible and/or fire

CALL 911 IMMEDIATELY

THE AIRCRAFT IS NOT TO BE MOVED EXCEPT FOR THE FOLLOWING CIRCUMSTANCES:

- 1. To remove persons injured or trapped
- 2. To protect the wreckage from further damage
- 3. To protect the public from injury

IN ANY OF THESE CASES, PHOTOS AND SKETCHES SHOULD BE MADE TO DOCUMENT THE ACCIDENT AND SURROUNDING AREA.

One of the following authorities shall be notified immediately in the following order:

Disaster Plan

- 1. Call 911
- 2. Grab Fire Extinguisher
- 3. Go to scene, assess area and help accordingly
- 4. Contact Cleveland FSDO and others
 - a. Flight Standards Office(440) 686-2001
 - b. Airport Manager Ric Blamer (216) 509-8858
 - c. GCAA President Chip Hess (440) 564-8008
 - d. GCCA VP Greg Gyllstrom...(734) 564-9084
- 5. Prior to the time the board (GCAA) or its authorized representative takes custody of the aircraft wreckage; mail or cargo may not be disturbed or moved except to the extent necessary to:
 - a. Move injured persons
 - b. Protect the wreckage from further damage
 - c. Protect the public from injury
