#### General Information - Effective September 1, 2020

The Country Caboose Wedding Chapel asks that you arrive on time for your scheduled ceremony. If your wedding is scheduled for 2:00 pm, then that means we will hold your wedding at 2:00 pm. If you are late and there are other weddings booked following yours, you may not get the full time as set forth in the packages and we want your ceremony to go as smoothly as possible with your allotted time. No weddings will be performed any evening after 9:30 pm or any morning before 9:00 am.

The Passenger Car will seat up to thirty (30) of your guests.

The Caboose will seat up to twelve (12) of your guests.

The Country Caboose Wedding Chapel will ask for a "Save the Date" deposit of 50% of your chosen ceremony package. This ensures that your date and time will be held just for you. The remainder of your balance will be due no less than fifteen (15) days before your ceremony. We will offer a refund of your "Save the Date" deposit if you cancel more than thirty (30) days before your ceremony. If you book your ceremony less than thirty (30) days ahead, the full amount of your ceremony package will be due at that time and no refunds will be offered at that point.

A wedding rehearsal may be pre-scheduled at the time of booking, if needed, and based on the availability of the chapel. There is an additional charge of \$100 for the rehearsal.

The Country Caboose Wedding Chapel will decorate the Caboose with basic white flowers and lights. You may choose flowers and decor from our collection to accent the white. We do have bouquets, a flower girl basket, and a ring bearer pillow available for you to borrow, if desired.

Jane Ballard Photography will print photos from your ceremony in house and have them available for you before you leave.

The Country Caboose Wedding Chapel is a non-smoking facility - indoors and outdoors. We do not have a liquor license, therefore we will not allow alcohol on our premises for insurance purposes.
