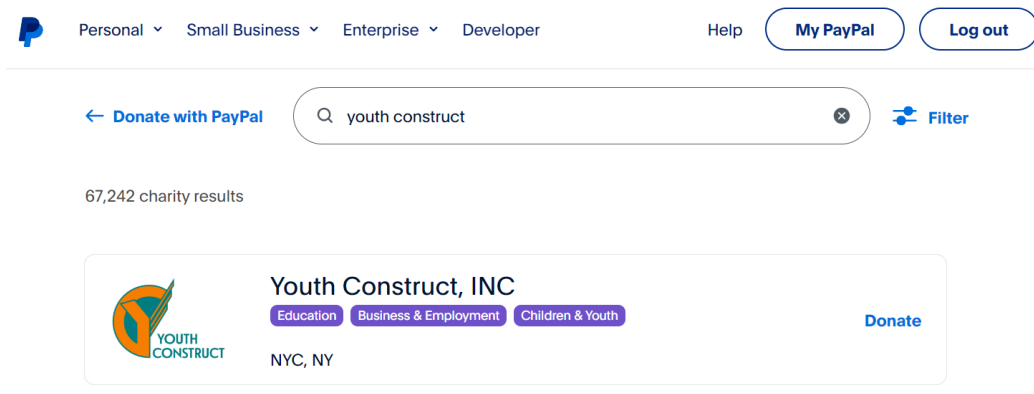


Dear Donor,

Thank you for your interest in donating to Youth Construct. Below are the instructions to donate to Youth Construct:

- **Via Zelle:** pay to alexis@youthconstruct.org linked to our TD Bank account
- **Via Give Lively:** In this link, <https://secure.givelively.org/donate/youth-construct-inc>), you can pay by Credit Card, ACH or PayPal
 - Note that if you are considering using PayPal, donation via Give Lively has lower transaction cost than PayPal
- **Via Paypal:** Directly via PayPal. You can search for the nonprofit “Youth Construct” or via this link <https://www.paypal.com/US/fundraiser/charity/4491286>



- **Via TD Bank.** We accept these forms of payment: ACH, Wire Transfer or Bill Pay. For account information and account address, please write to funding@youthconstruct.org.
- **Via our Brokerage Account:** You can also donate appreciated financial assets to our brokerage account at Edward Jones. To enable this, contact our account representative Tony Shaw at tony.shaw@edwardjones.com
- **Via Corporate Philanthropy Matching Donations:** After donating to us, do remember to check if your firm provides matching donations to charities of your choice. 60% of large US corporations have this program. In general, we appreciate your help to spread the words about us to your colleagues. - **Via Donor Advisory Fund (DAF):** A donor-advised fund is a vehicle for charitable giving that lets you make a committed contribution to a non-profit over multiple years, for which you receive an immediate tax deduction. - **Volunteer with YC:** We actively see volunteers of all backgrounds, especially:
 - Construction professionals who can provide guidance and instructions to our students
 - Business professionals who can assist in our operations, such as lawyers, accountants, financial advisors
 - Marketing and fundraising professionals who can help with event planner, external communications, grant writing, graphic design
- **Other in-kind donations:**
 - We also invite construction firms to provide our students with paid summer internships or organize networking events and on-site visits for our students.
 - Our students benefit from donations of meals, subway cards, and a wide range of supplies such as hard hats, computer equipment, and software subscriptions.
- **Fundraising assistance:**
 - Host an on-line fundraising campaign on social media such as facebook, instagram, LinkedIn and Give lively
 - Host an in-person fundraising event for the benefit of Youth Construct or dedicate an event, such as a company dinner or birthday dinner, for the benefit of Youth Construct.
 - Help make an introduction to potential donors, such as foundations, private and public organizations.
