JUDGES

KYLE A. FLOHRE

Kyle A. Flohre is currently the Band Director at Colonial Heights Middle School. He received his Bachelor of Music from James Madison University and Masters in Music Education at Virginia Commonwealth University.

Mr. Flohre was the Director of Bands at Colonial Heights High School from 2002-2022. Under the direction of Mr. Flohre, the ensembles at Colonial Heights High School consistently received superior ratings at Marching and Concert Assessments. Colonial Heights High School is a twenty-one time "Virginia Honor Band," with seventeen of those coming under Mr. Flohre's tenure. In 2008, Mr. Flohre was recognized by his peers and received the Colonial Heights High School "Teacher of the Year" award.

Mr. Flohre's professional affiliations include: NAfME, VMEA, VBODA, and Kappa Kappa Psi, and Phi Beta Mu International Bandmaster's Fraternity. He served as the District III VBODA representative and has been honored to judge at various marching band and VBODA Concert Assessments. Mr. Flohre and his wife Jennifer spend their free time trying to keep up with their energetic daughters - Emma, Lily, & Sophie.

MICHAEL AUMAN

Michael Auman is a Richmond, Virginia native who currently serves as the Director/Conductor of 3 bands at The Center of Belvedere in Charlottesville, Virginia. He was previously the Head Drumline Instructor at The University of Virginia in 2021. He started drumming at a very young age and has not stopped. His mother, Ruth Auman and his late father, Leon Auman, are respected music educators in The Commonwealth of Virginia and helped mold his talents at an early age. Mr. Auman was a Front Ensemble member of The Crossmen Drum and Bugle Corps in the early 2000's. After aging out, he took on such duties as wind and percussion arranger, drill writer, and most notably, The Director of Percussion at Mills E. Godwin High School in Henrico, Virginia from 2004-2021 and maintained a private studio of 30+ students a year during his time there. Michael has also been a member of The Richmond Philharmonic, Charlottesville Symphony, The Albemarle Symphony Orchestra, The Derbyshire Baptist Church Orchestra under Mr. David Schwoebel, The Richmond Pops Band under Mr. Joe Simpkins, The Cedar Creek Concert Band in Nashville, Tennessee under Mrs. Sherie Grossman, The Commonwealth Winds under Dr. Terry Austin, and performed the percussion book for two Broadway Shows at The Fringe Festival in Edinburgh, Scotland. When Michael is not playing music or teaching, he is competing in triathlons with his wife, Liz, training for a Half Ironman in 2023, making a fine cup of coffee, or snuggled on the couch with his dog Theodore and giant Flemish Rabbit, Violet.

DR. JARAUN RANSOME

Dr. Jaraun Ransome holds a Doctor of Education in Educational Leadership and Policy Studies from Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University, a Master of Arts in School Principalship from Central Michigan University, and a Bachelor of Music in Music Education from East Carolina University. Dr. Ransome was a director of bands in North Carolina and Virginia. Under his leadership the concert bands, marching bands, and jazz ensembles were consistent recipients of local, regional, national, and international honors, including the VBODA Honor Band Award, the VMEA Blue Ribbon Award, and the New Year's Day Parade in London, England. Dr. Ransome is a past member of the teaching faculty of the DCI World Finalist Blue Stars Drum and Bugle Corps. professional affiliations include the American Educational Research Association (AERA), Association of Positive Behavioral Supports (APBS), Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development (ASCD), the Honor Society of Phi Kappa Phi, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia Fraternity, the National Association of Music Educators (NAfME), and the Virginia Band Directors and Orchestra Directors Association (VBODA), and alumnus of Carolina Crown Drum and Bugle Corps. Dr. Ransome is the recipient of the 2015 Exemplary Professional School Counseling Advocate of Hampton Roads Award and the recipient of the Zeta Lambda Chapter's 2016 Alpha Phi Alpha Community Service Award. Dr. Ransome currently serves as the Program Administrator for Student Conduct and Discipline in the Office of the Chief of Staff in the Newport News Public School system. Dr. Ransome resides in Richmond, Virginia with his wife Stephanie and daughters Jada and Jenna.

TOMMY DANIELS

Tommy Daniels is the former Director of Bands at King George High School in King George, Virginia where he spent 8 years. Under the direction of Mr. Daniels, the ensembles at King George High School consistently received superior ratings at Virginia State Marching and Concert assessments. He led the band program to be recognized as a "Virginia Honor Band" every year during his tenure. In 2016, he was selected to participate in the U.S. Army All-American Marching Band Directors Academy. His professional affiliations include: NAfME, VMEA, and VBODA. Mr. Daniels resides in Fredericksburg, Virginia with his incredibly supportive and beautiful wife Natalie, their dog Gunner, and their two cats Kiki and Marla.

DUANE COSTON

Duane Coston serves on the faculty at Virginia Commonwealth University where he conducts the Wind Ensemble and University Band. Professor Coston also teaches courses in music education

Mr. Coston has been active in secondary and higher education for 18 years. Ensembles under his direction have been recognized for outstanding quality and professionalism. In 2009, Mr. Coston had the honor of performing at the Virginia Music Educators Association conference with the Lee-Davis Wind Ensemble. Mr. Coston was a semi-finalist at the Leonard Falcone International Euphonium Soloist Competition in 1995.

Duane Coston has served as guest conductor for the Hanover County High School Honors Band, Henrico Middle School Honors Band, and Henrico High School Honors Band. He has served as a guest speaker at the University of Florida and has served as a clinician and adjudicator across the Commonwealth of Virginia. Mr. Coston has been recognized as a "10 Year Virginia Honor Band Director" and has received the "Citation of Excellence" from the National Band Association.

Duane Coston completed his Bachelor of Music Education Degree at Virginia Commonwealth University and his Master of Music from James Madison University where he studied Euphonium Performance with Kevin Stees.

GREG THOMAS

Greg Thomas received his Bachelor's Degree and Master of Music Education Degree from Virginia Commonwealth University. He taught for 34 years in the Albemarle County Public Schools, including 26 years as the Band Director at Albemarle High School. He is currently on the Faculty of James Madison University where he conducts the Jazz Band, teaches Instrumental Arranging, and supervises student teachers. Mr. Thomas was recently inducted into the VBODA Band Director Hall of Fame in recognition of his contributions to music education in Virginia. Under his direction, the Albemarle High School Band was recognized seventeen times by the VBODA as a "Virginia Honor Band." He has presented multiple times at the State VMEA conference on the subject of creativity in the instrumental ensemble. Mr. Thomas is a member of VMEA, VBODA, Phi Beta Mu, VEA and is in demand as an adjudicator and clinician around the state of Virginia. Mr. Thomas has been an active performer all over the United States, and has performed with Gladys Knight, the Temptations, and other national and regional acts.

RICHARD HUGGINS

Richard Huggins has served as band director in Hanover county for the past ten years. Originally from Roanoke, Mr. Huggins studied at Longwood College and graduated from James Madison University. Mr. Huggins first taught elementary bands in Fairfax County and then in Washington County, Virginia.

Mr. Huggins served as band director at Patrick Henry High School in Glade Spring, VA, then

moved to Chesterfield County, where he taught for fifteen years. Mr. Huggins' ensembles have consistently earned superior ratings during his tenure. Mr. Huggins has marched with and served as an instructor for the Guardsmen Drum and Bugle Corps from Schaumburg, Illinois. He is an active adjudicator, clinician, and drill writer. His professional affiliations include VMEA, VBODA, NAFME, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia and Phi Beta Mu. Mr. Huggins lives in Mechanicsville with his wife Patti. They have two children, Laura and Daniel.

MR TONY "BABA D" MCCAIN

Mr. Tony "Baba D" McCain is a professional dancer, choreographer, adjudicator, consultant, and costume designer. Since 1983 Coach McCain has instructed 1000's of students, numerous award winning teams, high schools, workshops, clinics, camps, organizations, and independent ensembles. He currently serves as The Color Guard Coordinator for Powhatan High School, The Founder, Chairman, Creative Director of The Akoma Dance & Drum Performance Ensemble, Artistic Director of The Ngoma African Dance Ensemble at University of Richmond. Mr. McCain has also performed with The Carolina Gold Drum & Bugle Corps-Charter member and The Light Brigade World Winter Guard, which was The European Champions in 2007. He has also been awarded numerous Outstanding Performer Awards, served as a dance liaison in Senegal, West Africa, is a member of the Dzifa Masquerade Society, worked closely with the late Baba Chuck Davis' African American Dance Ensemble in Durham, NC and late Baba Melvin Deals' African Heritage Dancers and Drummers in Washington, DC. This marks his 41st year of experience in the Pageantry Arts. His educational background includes studying at VCU with a concentration in Physical Education and a minor in Dance/Choreography. In 2015, he was inducted into The Atlantic Indoor Association's Hall of Honor.


