Roast League - Game Rules & Step-by-Step Guide

Roast League is a fun, interactive, and high-energy football debate competition where passionate fans, comedians, and analysts battle in witty debates about the Premier League. The game follows a structured yet entertaining format, including fan engagement, audience voting, and unique challenges.

Game Format & Structure

Teams: Two teams of five debaters each, representing different perspectives or clubs.

Rounds: The match consists of three main debate rounds, with bonus segments and potential tiebreakers.

Judging: A panel of judges + audience participation determines the winner.

Time Per Round: Each round lasts 5-7 minutes per debate topic.

Step-by-Step Gameplay

1. THE ROAST ROUND – WHERE RIVALRIES GET REAL (20–30 MIN)

Two teams of passionate football fans go head-to-head in a heated, yet hilarious debate. Each team represents their favorite clubs, players, or football philosophies, using stats, banter, and wit to defend their stance.

How It Works:

The host announces a debate topic (e.g., "Is Pep Guardiola overrated without Messi?").

Each team has Three minutes to make their opening argument.

Opponents fire back with counterpoints and quick comebacks.

The audience reacts live, voting for the best arguments and throwing soft balls at weak ones!

Pro Tip: The funnier and more knowledgeable you are, the more likely you are to win over the crowd!

2. THE TRIVIA BATTLE - PROVE YOUR FOOTBALL IQ

Football isn't just about opinions—it's about knowledge. In this round, teams face off in a quick-fire Premier League trivia battle, testing their knowledge of historic moments, stats, and legendary players.

How It Works:

The host fires rapid trivia questions at both teams.

A wrong answer? Penalty time! The opposing team gets to steal.

Some questions come with special challenges—like acting out a player celebration!

The team with the most correct answers wins extra votes going into the final round.

Pro Tip: Stay sharp! If you fumble a simple question, expect roasts from the audience!

3. RED CARD EJECTIONS – IF YOU CAN'T TAKE THE HEAT, YOU'RE OUT!

Roast League is all about fast thinking and quick comebacks. But if your arguments are weak, off-topic, or just plain boring—you get a red card!

How It Works:

Judges and the audience can issue red cards for:

Dodging the question

Uninspired arguments

Too much complaining (VAR-style whining won't save you!)

Getting completely roasted with no comeback

Two red cards = Ejection from the debate!

Pro Tip: If you're in trouble, win the crowd back with a bold take, a savage comeback, or a legendary football fact!

4. THE CHAMPION'S CIRCLE – WHO WINS?

At the end of the show, the judges and audience vote for the winners based on:

Best argument & debate performance

Most entertaining & funniest moments

Crowd engagement & reactions

The winning team gets bragging rights, prizes, and a guaranteed spot in the next Roast League showdown!

Think you've got what it takes? Join the debate and prove you're the ultimate football fan!

Each team selects one player for the Final Roast Battle.

They get 60 seconds to deliver their most convincing or hilarious takedown.

The judges score based on:

Humor & Entertainment (30%)

Football Knowledge & Facts (30%)

Delivery & Charisma (20%)

Audience Engagement (20%)

BONUS SEGMENTS & FAN INTERACTIONS

Red Card Challenge

If a player makes a weak argument or too much trash talk, the audience or judges can issue a Red Card. A Red Carded player:

Must complete a challenge or punishment (e.g., a funny football trivia question).

If they fail, they are benched for one round.

Penalty Shootout (Tiebreaker Round)

If the match is too close to call, teams enter a Penalty Shootout debate.

Each team rapidly answers 3 debate prompts, with 20 seconds per response.

Judges and audience decide the final goal or miss.

AUDIENCE VOTING & INTERACTIVE FEATURES

Live Voting: Fans in the venue and online can vote on:

Best arguments

Funniest moments

Who should be "Roast MVP"

Soft Ball Throwing: Audience members throw soft foam balls to challenge weak points or support strong arguments.

Social Media Polls: Viewers on YouTube, Twitter, and Instagram can interact in real-time.

WINNING & REWARDS

The team with the highest score at the end wins and moves up in the Roast League standings. Individual MVP Award: The best performer gets the Golden Mic Award. Fans who engage the most (best audience question or comment) win prizes & merch.

OFFICIAL RULES & CONDUCT

No Personal Attacks: Roast League is about football, not personal insults.

No Offensive Language: Trash talk is encouraged but must follow community guidelines. Respect the Judges & Audience: Arguing with the judges can result in a Yellow Card warning.

Participation Consent: Attendees agree to be filmed & featured in live broadcasts.

FINAL NOTES

The winner of each match moves up in the Roast League standings.

Special "Derby Nights" feature legendary club rival debates.

Fans can apply to participate by registering through the website.
