Kevin D. Johnson and Jocelyn were getting married at Salt Lake Temple on June 9, 1978 'til her death after nearly 26 years of her marriage life. We are missing her so long toward Heaven at this recent time. He also missed his loving wife so long.

Her couple went on her Honeymoon to Idaho Falls, Hebgen Lake, Yellowstone N.P., and Teton Mtn. after married on June 1978. Then they also lived at our same home at Glenrose Dr. for all of our marriage life.

Her husband still works at Valley Machine and Manufacturing, Inc.

They were glad to have our daughter, Christina. and that's all they have one child because before her kidneys started to be failed on 1980. They also were glad we have 5-month-old grandson, Samuel James King at this recent time.

Her family also had been good time during on trips to Flaming Gorge, Deep Creek Mtn., some places in Arizona, California, Idaho, Montana, Colorado, Wyoming, Kansas, Missouri, Illinois, Ohio, New York, Pennsylvania, New York, Maryland, Virginia, and D.C. and Canada. We also had been toured all places where Joseph Smith's church history as before. They also enjoyed camping, fishing, touring, etc. with other families on somewhere in Utah during past several years. We also had good time with the groups of National Kidney Foundation during at Kidney Kamp at Aspen Grove on Sept. 2001 and 2003.

She also had her hobbies as computing, crocheting, help caring our yard, watching TV, cooking, reading scriptures, books, etc., scrap books, etc.

Her duties at our church were counselor young women pres., primary leader, activity committee with her husband, and relief society lesson teacher.

In fact of ,her serious medical were listed in details :

Her kidney was transplanted from her dad's donor on May 5, 1980. But it was rejected after working for 5 months.

Her another kidney was transplanted from the dead body on August 1986. But it also was rejected after nine months.

She also had her several other kinds of surgeries as before.

Her lower left leg was amputated at Cottonwood Hospital on April 3, 2002. after her bad disease on it. Then she still had her wheelchair, walker, and her short-term artificial leg. She also had been stayed in some hospitals during several overnights as before.

But in exception of when she had been no overnight there during several other years as before.

She still had been at her dialysis nearly 24 years.

In our lately year, she also had her worse scleroderma, respiratory problems, lower blood pressure, loss appetite, some fever, and other disease.

She also had her part colon and gall bladder remove surgery at LDS Hosp. on Feb. 22 and was getting better within past two weeks. Then she got her pain with her rupture colon again and went back there. During on her last chance of staying at LDS Hospital, she had her another time of her surgery with open abdomen surgery for monitoring and cleaning out inside her abdomen when she was sleeping during few days there. Then we were expecting in our meeting with doctors, counseling, and nurses about her resigned temporal life away from worse disease. So since sometimes she had been said she wanted to die soon for her better and healthy spiritual life with no more tired of her painful life. We also knew her as good faithful and in her more prayerful time. We also thanked for many other ones in our prayers for her for strengthening her soul. Then she started to passed away peacefully on the hospital bed between her husband and her daughter and with her friends, Denise and her mom, Adelaide Andra and a nurse behind the bed last Wednesday, March 10th at 11:20 PM. We were so sad. Then we knew about her whole soul to be restored toward Heaven. We also thanked her nice doctors and nurses there.
