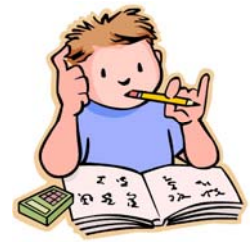


We-Learn About the New ILEARN State Assessment Math Grades 3-4-5

The purpose of this workshop is to help educators understand and prepare for the new ILEARN state math assessment scheduled for April-May of 2019. The Department of Education (DOE) has provided very helpful resources for students, parents, and teachers to achieve this goal.

The objectives of the workshop are to:

- learn about the connections among content standards, process standards, depth of knowledge levels (DOK) and problem solving strategies.*
- learn how to evaluate the (DOK) level for math problems and/or activities.*
- learn how to use new resources provided by the DOE linked to the new ILEARN state math assessment for 2018-19.*
- learn how to use other classroom-ready math resources aligned to the new ILEARN state math assessment for school year 2018-19.*
- create a new math curriculum map (calendar) based upon the 2014 Indiana Academic Standards with a particular focus on “Super Standards.”*
- work in grade-level teams to create DOK math problems and/or performance tasks at level 3.*
- work in grade-level teams to create bell ringer activities or math problems aligned to the “Super Standards.”*

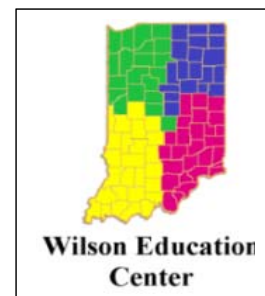
