## *An Opportunity for a Deep Dive*

In the 2019-2020 school year, the College Board is introducing a suite of new resources. These tools were designed and tested in collaboration with AP educators. AP teachers will be able to use them throughout the year to help students learn college-level content and skills. Resources include:

- AP Questions Banks
  - Filtered by course content and skills
  - Used to create customized practice tests
  - Assigned online or on paper as in-class assignments or homework
- Progress Dashboard
  - Pinpointing strengths and weaknesses on AP content and skills
  - Charting class and student progress throughout the school year
  - Equipping students to monitor their own progress and take steps to improve
- Updates Unit Guides
  - An outline of exact content skills covered on exam
  - Pacing and sequencing suggestions to help teachers integrate material into their courses
  - Unit weighting to focus instruction on topics that will make the biggest impact
