



As many of you know or may have heard, a group of superintendents and aspiring superintendents in July 2019 heard from researcher John Hattie whose work *Visible Learning* synthesized more than 800 meta-studies and identified more than 250 factors that impact student achievement. East Allen County Schools has begun working with a Visible Learning team from Corwin to put Hattie's research into a "practical inquiry model" for its teachers and administrators.

On September 10, 2019, Karen Flores, a member of the Visible Learning team, will be working in the East Allen school district with its teachers and administrators in the afternoon. In the morning, Karen will be available to meet with Education Service Center representatives and member districts to explain the Visible Learning model of professional inquiry and what this could look like for the schools across the state of Indiana.
