Roasters and stewers can be rabbits that are already entered as juniors, intermediates and seniors

Meat pens

- -consist of three rabbits, all the same breed and variety, but not necessarily from the same litter
- -not over 10 weeks of age
- -minimum weight 3 ½ pounds
- -Maximum weight 5 ½ pounds

Fryers

- -not over 10 weeks of age
- -Minimum weight 3 ½ pounds
- -Maximum weight 5 ½ pounds

Fryers can be rabbits that are already entered as meat pens.

- 6. Tattoo number changes within class are allowed up until the time of check in, Friday, April 19 at 8:00 PM.
