THE CHALLANGE: HIGH CONFLICT CUSTODY CASES

Overlooked Children: Many children suffer silently in high-conflict custody disputes, a group often overlooked by traditional child welfare efforts.

DID YOU KNOW?

- 50% of children witness their parents' relationships end.
- Children in these situations are **twice as likely** to drop out of high school.
- There is a **16% increase** in behavioral and emotional issues among these children.
- Children of divorced parents are **twice as likel**y to commit suicide.

CLOSING THE GAP

The Layne Project 4 Families addresses the needs of children caught in high-conflict custody disputes by:

Providing Holistic Support: We support both households, offering a comprehensive approach to reduce parental conflict and safeguard children's well-being.

Expanding Services: We served 287 families in the Kansas City Metropolitan area last year and aim to double this number.

WHY YOUR SUPPORT MATTERS

Critical Need: There is a growing demand for our services, especially among families who cannot afford private interventions (costing \$3,000 to \$18,000 over 12 to 18 months).

Reducing Conflict: The best predictor of a child's well-being during parental separation is the level of conflict between parents. We aim to minimize this to protect children from unnecessary trauma.

Supporting Vulnerable Families: In Johnson County, KS, 1 in 4 children relies on the free or reduced lunch program, and 46% of families struggle to meet daily expenses. By reducing conflict, we help these families find peace and stability.
