

This is the last Will and testament of Me John Doiron of Hope River Lot or Township Number Twenty-two in Queens County in Prince Edward Island, farmer, I give and devise to my son John Doiron the fifty acres of land on which I now reside to hold unto my said son John Doiron his heirs and assigns for ever. I give and devise to my son Stanislaus Doiron the fifty acres of land situate on the South side of the fifty acres on which I now reside and which I have devised to my son John Doiron to hold the same unto my said son Stanislaus Doiron his heirs and assigns forever. Whereas there is now a Mortgage for five hundred dollars on the whole one hundred acres above devised to my sons John and Stanislaus given by me to the Credit Foncier Franco-Canadien now it is my wish and desire that both farms so willed to my said sons John and Stanislaus as aforesaid shall be charged equally for the payment of the said sum and my said sons John and Stanislaus shall be equally liable for the payment of the said sum of five hundred dollars and also for the payment of the yearly interest And further it is my wish and desire that if either of my said sons John or Stanislaus wishes to sell his fifty acres of land so willed to him as aforesaid he shall first offer the same for sale to the other of them. I give and bequeath to my ^{said} son Stanislaus one horse one Cow and three Sheep.

I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary one Cow and two Sheep to be given her when she marries My said daughter Mary is to be supported by my son John until she marries. I give and bequeath to the Parish Priest of Hope River the sum of fifteen dollars for Masses for the benefit of

Soul. I give and bequeath to my said son John all the rest of my personal property of every kind and description. And I appoint Dejene Peters my son in law the executor of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former and other wills and Codicils by me at any time heretofore made.
