Course: 25 metre, 8 lanes, starting blocks and Omega Electronic Timing System
Timed Finals Meet.

Rules: British Columbia Summer Swim Association (BCSSA) rules apply.

Entries: Club entries must be received before 7:00pm, Tuesday June 12th, 2018. Please e-mail
Hy-Tek entries to registrar@oakbayorcas.ca and include club roster list for deck entries.

Swimmers must be entered with an official BCSSA time. If a swimmer has never swum an event, enter them with a NT. Do not make up times!

Swimmers may enter a maximum of 7 individual events, plus 2 relays.

Please enter 'O' swimmers into their respective 'O' event, AND their respective 'S' event, as described in "How to enter O swimmers" available on the region website. FYI - 'O' events will have no cost in the meet so that the 'O' swimmers are not charged double.

Meet fees, payable to Oak Bay Orcas, must be handed in to the Clerk of the Course before the end of the meet on Sunday.

Fees: \$7.00 per individual event. \$8.00 per relay. Novice events are free.
\$12.00 per individual deck entry. (Deck entries will be added to club bills.)
There is an additional High Performance Fee of \$5 per swimmer charged by Saanich Commonwealth Pool. This is payable with your meet fees.

Welcome Coaches: Coaches will be offered deck food during the meet.

Deck Entries: Must be submitted to the Clerk of the Course by 11:30 am on Saturday and 8:30am on Sunday. **Deck entries will be allowed at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course** on the day of the meet. **Athlete BCSSA # and birthdate must be provided if you do not send a club roster with your entries.** Deck entry swimmers will NOT be seeded and will be fit in to events where available, if accepted by the Clerk of the Course. Deck Entries MUST be accompanied with payment.

Scratches: Scratches must be submitted to the Clerk of the Course by **11:30am on Saturday** and **8:30am on Sunday**. No refunds for missed or scratched events.

Novice: A novice swimmer is defined as a swimmer who takes 30 seconds or more to complete 25 meters of the pool. Novices are stroke specific. Once a novice has swum a 50 m event (including relays) they will no longer be a novice swimmer in that stroke. All novice events will be raced on Sunday.

Relays: Relay teams will be seeded in their appropriate Division regardless of the number of "O" swimmers on the team. If more than one "O" swimmer is on a relay team, that relay will be treated as an "O" Cat relay in the final results. Relay entry cards must be handed in to the Clerk of the Course by 1:00pm Saturday and 10:00am Sunday. All relay teams must have 4 Swimmers

Heat Sheets: A limited number of Heat Sheets will be sold for \$5 each morning. Heat Sheet will also be available on line on the Orcas Website. Events will also be updated to the Meet Mobile App.

Marshalling: Swimmers will report to marshalling when their event number is posted. Divisions 1-3 will be marshaled; all others must check in for their event at the marshalling table but then are responsible to be behind the blocks in time for their races. There will be Full Marshalling for all divisions for Relays. ****Announcements made over the Public Address are courtesy calls only****

Event Seeding: All events will be raced as timed finals. Swimmers with no times will be seeded in the slower races.

Results: Results will be posted on the wall above the Bleachers on the North side of the Facility.

Disabled Swimmers: Coaches must notify the Meet Manager at the beginning of the meet of any swimmers with disabilities. Disabled swimmers must attempt to swim the proper stroke.

Meet Information:

Splash for Cash!! This is open to all swimmers in Division 1 through 7 (Div 8 and OCAT not eligible). The fastest swimmer of each Division plus one WildCard for each Girls and Boys from Saturday's 50m Freestyle will each compete in a Final on Sunday after the Novice Events. Based on the swimmer's time from Saturday, the Final on Sunday will be Handicapped giving head starts to swimmers with slower times to make the finish closer and more fair. If your club does "Thunderdome" during practice it will be similar to this for the start.

There will be a separate race for each Girls and Boys with each having the following Prize Breakdown:

1st - \$150 2nd \$100 3rd \$50 4th – 8th \$10 each.

To be eligible to race in Sunday's final, the swimmers MUST have competed in at least one other *individual* race on both Saturday AND Sunday. Scratching/no show from the other events will result in the swimmer not being eligible to race in the Splash for Cash final.

Finalists for Sunday's Splash for Cash will be posted alongside Meet Results before Relays start on Saturday. There WILL be MARSHALLING for the Splash for Cash final.
