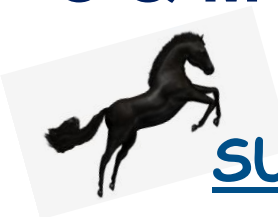

Week 4- July 27-31		**** Advanced camp is open to riders who can walk trot and canter in an open field and have started jumping. Riders must be able to handle and tack up horses without assistance.
