

❄️ Protect Your Pool from Freeze Damage ❄️

Freeze damage can get expensive! Here's a quick checklist to help keep your pool safe!

Please note: this list is only a recommendation, not a guarantee.

- ✔️ **Keep Water Moving**
 - Run the pump continuously or confirm freeze protection is working.
 - It is normal for "freeze protect" to alternate between pool and spa mode.
 - Make sure valves are open and water is circulating through all lines.
- ✔️ **Check Water Level**
 - Keep it mid-skimmer to prevent the pump from sucking air.
- ✔️ **Clear Baskets**
 - Empty skimmer and pump baskets for proper flow.
- ✔️ **Protect Equipment**
 - Cover pump and heater (don't block airflow).
 - Store cleaners and hoses indoors.
- ✔️ **If Power Goes Out or Your System is Down**
 - Turn off breakers to pool equipment.
 - Remove drain plugs from pump, filter, and heater.
 - Open valves, remove lids and cover exposed pipes with towels or blankets.
