All contestants should be ready to serve by 5:25 PM.

Tickets are sold at the door for \$5.00. This allows the taster five votes and all the soup they care to taste. Additional votes are \$1.00 each. Tea and coffee are provided with the purchase of tickets.

The **Dessert Auction** will be held at 7:00 PM.
