We are a mixed billing practice; the following fees will be applicable.

We have EFTPOS and Credit card facilities available.

Pension and/or Concession card holders and children under 15 will be bulk billed

Procedures

Procedures such as Iron Infusions, Mirena insertion, biopsies etc will incur an out-of-pocket fee for all patients (including concession card holders)

Please speak to reception to discuss this further.

Dressings/Bandages and other consumables

Due to the costs associated with wound care, all patients (including concession card holders) will be asked to contribute to the cost of dressings, bandages, and other consumable items.

Medical reports, work injuries and transport accidents are not eligible for Medicare rebates and cannot be bulk billed.

- Medical reports: depending on information payment required on the day.
- Employment medicals: Depending on information payment required on the day.
- Sports medicals: Depending on information payment required on the day.
- Work injuries/Work Cover: Accounts must be paid on the day of appointment unless prior arrangement made with employer written on letter head / acceptance letter from insurance company.
- Transport accidents (TAC): must be paid for on the day unless you provide us with a letter stating TAC has accepted your claim.
- Travel vaccines and other vaccines: Unless eligible to have the government funded vaccine payment is on the day
