OYAP/COOP Intake Requirements:

- 4 credit co-op students only (full day targeting approx. 400 hours in a semester)
- Mathematically inclined students
- Students will be interviewed
- WEHBA contractors will place successful applicants at job sites
- Students will require their own mode of transportation as job locations vary

A complete application package will include:

- WEHBA Application
- Resume
- Attendance record
- Credit counselling summary

Application Process Schedule:

- Students must be registered for 4 credit COOP
- Application packages due January 15th to board designates:
 - o GECDSB Jason Lepain
 - o WECDSB-
- Interviews with WEHBA will take place starting February 10th (location TBD)
- Successful applicants and COOP teachers will be notified by February 14th
- COOP Placement Timeline:
 - o February 3rd through February 14th (Preplacement Paperwork, Health & Safety Training, etc.)
 - o February 17th through June 19th COOP Placement on Jobsite(s)
