A Message from The CEO/President



As Community Clinics around the nation brace for the “Fiscal Cliff”, where Federal Qualified Health Centers like MCCN will face a 70% cut in their grant from HRSA unless Congress acts on it soon. The current funding ends on September 30.

Per the National Association of Community Health Centers, without the Congress extending the funding, the dire consequences include 2,800 clinic sites closed and more than 50,000 jobs eliminated. We all urge you to help in educating your congressperson as to why it is urgent to keep the funding!

MCCN Awarded Supplemental Funding

Recently, MCCN was awarded an additional \$175,700 supplemental funding to expand access to mental health services, and substance abuse services focusing on the treatment, prevention, and awareness of opioid abuse. We would use this grant to hire more staff to increase access to behavioral health including reducing the opioid usage by our patients.
