MCCN is proud to be a recipient of the 2016 HRSA Substance Abuse grant. One of the 36 grants awarded to California community clinics. One of the primary goals of this grant is to reduce the dependency on Opioids in our primary care patients. In 2014, there were more than 47,000 deaths in the United States due to Opioids overdose per the Center of Disease Control. Within its 14 sites in Los Angeles and San Bernardino County, MCCN had approximately 800 patients who are prescribed Opioids. With this grant, we will be able to train our primary care providers in techniques to reduce the dependency on Opioids by our patients.

Additionally, we will be hiring substance abuse counselors to provide assistance to patients that are dependent on alcohol or drugs.

Health and Human Services (HHS) Secretary Sylvia M. Burwell reported at time of announcement of this grant "That the opioid epidemic is one of the most pressing public health issues in the United States today".

This grant will also assist in integrating primary care with behavioral health services as we train our providers in SBIRT (Screen, Brief Intervention and Referral to Treatment).

In 2015, MCCN provided behavioral health services to more than 5,000 patients as we celebrate one year of providing tele behavioral health services and use technology to provide services to our patients.
