Welcome to Mission City Community Network, Inc.'s. (MCCN) third quarter Newsletter.

MCCN prides itself in providing quality health care to the underinsured and underserved.

Mission City Community Network, Inc. (MCCN) is proud to announce being a recipient of a grant from Health Resources Services Administration (HRSA), Delivery System Health Information Investment (DSHII). The grant will assist MCCN in improving our technology infrastructure as we expand our services to many Californians that still remain uninsured or don't have access to affordable health care.

MCCN started their pilot Telehealth Program over a year ago and now we are pleased to announce that we are providing over 1000 Telehealth visits per month, giving access to all of our sites.

I am also pleased to announce that we will be adding dental services to our Pomona clinic, which is located at 1818 N. Orange Grove Avenue, Ste. 205, Pomona, CA 91767.

MCCN will soon be opening its doors to its new Culver City clinic. Medical and Behavioral health services will be provided to its local residents.

MCCN - Mobile Health Center at LAUSD

Mission City Community Network operates its Mobile School-Based Health Center "Community Clinic On Wheels" on the campus of LAUSD Schools that includes Pacoima Middle School, Sylmar High School, Sylmar Biotech School, Northridge Academy High School, Maywood Academy High School, Grant High School and the 4 academies of Cesar E. Chavez Academies (Social Justice Humanitus Academy, Arts Entertainment School, Academy of Scientific Exploration, and Teacher Prep Academy). MCCN Mobile Clinic provides medical, dental and mental health services to the students including access to health care and primary provider during school day. The program through direct partnership and collaboration with the school principals and faculty staff and school nurse from LAUSD School Nursing District. Students are being referred by school nurse who can arrange for appropriate care/treatment. To date, MCCN also expanded its Community Clinic On Wheels Services to elementary schools and pre-school namely to Michelle Obama Elementary School in Panorama and Grant Early Education Center in North Hollywood.
